This report contains estimates of the population by marital status, age and sex, for Canada and the provinces for 1952, and also revised estimates by marital status and sex covering the period, 1942-1950.

Using the 1951 Census statistics on marital status by age and sex as a base, vital statistics data on marriages and deaths by marital status, age and sex, and on dissolutions of marriages, as well as immigration statistics by marital status, age and sex, for the year period June 1, 1951 to June 1, 1952, were applied to the census figures to obtain estimates of the population by marital status, age, and sex for 1952. In making these calculations allowance was also made for the marital status, age, and sex composition of the estimated number of emigrants over this period. Finally, the age totals in Table 2 were adjusted to correspond with the official population estimates by age and sex for 1952, published in the D.B.S. Reference Paper No. 40.

In Table 1. will be found revised estimates of population by marital status and sex for provinces over the period, 1942-1950. These revised estimates are being released for the first time since the 1951 Census. Vital statistics data on deaths by marital status and age were not available by provinces for the whole period, 1942-1950, hence the marital status estimates for this period, as shown in Table 1, are not further sub-divided by age groups.

Le présent rapport contient les estimations de la population du Canada et de ses provinces pour 1952, selon l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe. Il contient en outre des estimations revisées selon l'état matrimonial et le sexe pour la période de 1942-1950.

Afin d'obtenir les estimations de la population selon l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe pour 1952, on s'est servi, comme base, des statistiques du recensement de 1951 sur l'état matrimonial selon l'âge et le sexe auxquelles on a appliqué les données d'état civil sur les mariages et les décès selon l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe et sur les dissolutions de mariages, de même que les statistiques de l'immigration selon l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe pour la période d'un an du 1er juin 1951 au 1er juin 1952. Dans ces calculs, on a tenu compte aussi de la composition selon l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe du nombre estimatif d'émigrants au cours de la période. Finalement, on a rectifié les totaux du tableau pour qu'ils correspondent avec les estimations officielles de la population selon l'âge et le sexe pour 1952, publiées dans le document de référence n° 40 du Bureau fédéral de la statistique.

Le tableau 1 contient des estimations revisées de la population des provinces selon l'état matrimonial et le sexe pour la période de 1942-1950. C'est la première fois que ces chiffres sont publiés depuis le recensement de 1951. Les données d'état civil sur les décès selon l'état matrimonial et l'âge ne sont pas disponibles par province pour la période entière de 1942-1950. C'est pourquoi les estimations relatives à l'état matrimonial pour cette période (1942-1950) ne sont pas resubdivisées par groupes d'âge.
