### ESTIMATIONS DE LA POPULATION SELON L'ÉTAT MATRIMONIAL, L'ÂGE ET LE SEXE, CANADA ET PROVINCES, 1954

This report provides estimates of the population by marital status, age and sex, for Canada and the provinces for 1954, with comparative data for 1951, 1952, and 1953.

Using the estimated 1953 figures on marital status by age and sex as a base, vital statistics data on marriages and deaths by marital status, age and sex, and on dissolutions of marriages, as well as immigration statistics by marital status, age and sex, for the year period June 1, 1953 to June 1, 1954, were applied to the estimated figures for 1953 to obtain estimates of the population by marital status, age and sex, for 1954. Allowance has also been made for the marital status, age and sex composition of the estimated number of emigrants over this period. Finally, the age totals in Table 1 were adjusted to correspond with the official population estimates by age and sex for 1954, published in the 1954 Supplement to D.B.S. Reference Paper No. 40.

The estimated total population of Canada on June 1, 1954 was 15,168,000, of whom 10,376,600 were 15 years of age and over. The estimated total of males, 15 years of age and over, was 5,236,000, of whom 1,609,700 or 30.7 p.c. were single, 3,423,100 or 65.4 p.c. were married, and 203,200 or 3.9 p.c. were widowed or divorced. The estimated total of females, 15 years of age and over, was 5,140,600, of whom 1,224,600 or 23.8 p.c. were single, 3,397,600 or 66.1 p.c. were married, and 518,400 or 10.1 p.c. were widowed or divorced.

The difference between males and females in the proportionate importance of the widowed and divorced groups is due to the much larger number of widowed females than males in the population. The rise in the percentage married since 1951 was most marked in the age group, 15-24 years, where the percentage for males increased from 13.3 to 16.2 in 1954, and from 30.1 in 1951 to 34.7 in 1954 for females. This change is reflected in a 27.6 p.c. increase over this period in the number of married males, 15-24, and of 17.1 p.c. in the number of married females. In the age group, 65 years and over, the proportion of widowed women of the total rose from 48 p.c. at the 1951 Census to 51.8 p.c. in 1954. There was a slight fall over this period in the proportion of widowed males among total males 65 years and over. Since death rates for both males and females over 65 years have fallen over the same period, it would appear that the increase in the extent of widowhood among women in this age group was due partly to relative changes in the age composition of males and females over 65 years of age since 1951. Widowed women 65 years and over, showed an 18.3 p.c. increase between 1951 and 1954.

Le présent rapport contient les estimations de la population du Canada et des provinces selon l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe pour 1954. Il contient aussi des données comparées pour 1951, 1952, et 1953.

Les chiffres estimatifs de 1953 sur l'état matrimonial selon l'âge et le sexe servant de base, les données de l'état civil sur les mariages et les décès selon l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe, et sur les dissolutions de mariage, de même que les statistiques de l'immigration selon l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe pour la période du 1<sup>er</sup> juin 1953 au 1<sup>er</sup> juin 1954 ont été appliquées aux chiffres estimatifs de 1953, ce qui a donné une estimation de la population selon l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe pour 1954. On a tenu compte de la composition selon l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe du nombre d'émigrants au cours de la période. Finalement, les totaux quant à l'âge (tableau 1) ont été rectifiés pour qu'ils correspondent avec les estimations officielles de la population selon l'âge et le sexe pour 1953 et 1954 et publiées dans le supplément de 1953 du Document de référence de B.F.S. n° 40.

La population estimative du Canada le 1<sup>er</sup> juin 1954 était de 15,168,000 habitants dont 10,376,600 étaient âgés de 15 ans et plus. Le total estimatif d'hommes âgés de 15 ans et plus était de 5,236,000 dont 1,609,700 ou 30.7 p. 100 étaient célibataires, 3,423,100 ou 65.4 p. 100 mariés, et 203,200 ou 3.9 p. 100 veufs ou divorcés. Le nombre estimatif de femmes âgées de 15 ans et plus était de 5,140,600 dont 1,224,600 ou 23.8 p. 100 étaient en célibataires, 3,397,600 ou 66.1 p. 100, mariées et 518,400 ou 10.1 p. 100 veuves ou divorcées.

La différence quant à l'importance proportionnelle entre les femmes divorcées ou veuves et les hommes des mêmes catégories, est due au nombre beaucoup plus élevé de veuves que de veufs parmi la population. L'augmentation proportionnelle du pourcentage de personnes mariées depuis 1951 a été très prononcée dans le groupe d'âge de 15 à 24 ans, où l'augmentation chez les hommes a été de 13.3 p. 100 en 1951 à 16.2 p. 100 en 1954 et, chez les femmes, de 30.1 p. 100 en 1951 à 34.7 p. 100 en 1954. Ce changement se traduit par une augmentation de 27.6 p. 100, chez les hommes mariés âgés de 15 à 24 ans au cours de la période et une augmentation de 17.1 p. 100 chez les femmes mariées du même groupe. Dans le groupe des 65 ans et plus, la proportion de veuves par rapport à la population féminine totale s'est élevée de 48 p. 100 lors de recensement de 1951 à 51.8 p. 100 en 1954. La proportion de veufs parmi la population masculine de même groupe d'âge a diminué un peu durant la période. Étant donné que le taux des décès tant chez les hommes que chez les femmes âgées de plus de 65 ans a diminué au cours de la même période, il semble que l'augmentation du veuvage chez les hommes de ce groupe d'âge soit due dans une certaine mesure aux changements relatifs qui se sont produits depuis 1951 dans la composition par âge de la population masculine et féminine âgée de plus de 65 ans. Les veuves âgées de plus de 65 ans ont augmenté de 18.3 p.c. entre 1951 et 1954.
