#### MONTHLY AND QUARTERLY REPORTS ON THE PHYSICAL VOLUME OF INVENTORIES

- 1. The attached tables list the information about physical volume of inventories which is collected at monthly or quarterly intervals by the Census of Industry units within the Industry and Merchandising Division of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.
- 2. The first two columns state the type of information collected and the time interval. The next column names the form which is used and gives a reference number. Where there are two or more versions, such as an English and a French, only one reference is given. Altogether, 62 commodity groups are listed. The publications, if any, in which information is made available are shown next, together with a brief note on the amount of information published. The section handling the data is named in the right-hand column, and any other comments are also placed there.
- 5. The information is arranged according to the volumes and parts of the Census of Industry annual publications. This ensures easy reference for anyone familiar with the annual reports. Since the organization of the Division coincides closely with the arrangement of the annual reports, administrative references are also simple. References based on the Standard Industrial Classification can be made fairly simply, because the layout of annual publications is based on that classification.
