## **FOREWORD**


This publication contains the revised estimates of population for counties and census divisions which were published in the annual series for the years 1967 to 1970 under Catalogue 91-206. The estimates have been revised in the light of the 1971 Census counts and provide population as of June 1 of each year. Though there have been some changes in boundaries in 1971, for the sake of consistency and comparability, the boundaries of counties and census divisions existing in 1966 have been maintained throughout. These changes will be incorporated in the estimates beginning in 1972.

These revised estimates are prepared by the Estimates Unit of the Population Estimates and Projections Section, Census Branch.

## **AVANT-PROPOS**

Ce bulletin présente une révision des estimations de la population par comté et par division de recensement qui ont été publiées dans la série annuelle des années 1967 à 1970 au catalogue 96-206. On a effectué cette révision à la lumière des résultats du recensement de 1971 et les estimations rendent compte de la population au 1er juin de chaque année. Bien que l'on ait apporté certaines modifications au découpage géographique du recensement en 1971, on a conservé pour ces estimations les limites de 1966 des comtés et des divisions de recensement par souci de continuité et de comparabilité des données. À partir de 1972, les estimations tiendront compte de ces modifications.

Les présentes estimations révisées ont été préparées par la Sous-section des estimations de la Section des estimations et projections démographiques de la Direction du recensement.



## INTRODUCTION

### REVISED ESTIMATES OF POPULATION FOR COUNTIES AND CENSUS DIVISIONS

The present report contains the revised estimates for 223 counties and census divisions for the years 1967 to 1970 and represents the consolidation of the annual series of reports published under Catalogue 91-206. The estimates are provided for all the provinces in Canada, but not Yukon and Northwest Territories.

The estimates refer to the population as of June 1 of each year. June 1 coincides with the date of decennial and quinquennial censuses as well as the date of annual post-censal estimates of population for Canada and the provinces.

The methodology of revision is the same as that used in the revising of the provincial estimates. It consists of progressively distributing the difference between the estimate for 1971 and the 1971 Census count in respect of each county and census division over the years 1967 to 1970. If we suppose that 'd' is the difference between the 1971 Census count and 1971 estimate for a particular county or census division, then  $d/5$  is added to the 1967 estimate,  $2d/5$  is added to the 1968 estimate, and so on. This essentially takes into account the adjustment for differential growth or decline of population in each county or census division during the quinquennial period 1966 to 1971. The revised total for all the counties and census divisions within a province, however, has been adjusted to conform to the revised total for that province in the annual provincial estimates. The methodology of arriving at the unrevised post-censal estimates in respect of counties and census divisions in each province is detailed in the 1967 report (Catalogue 91-206).

As has been emphasized in earlier reports, the figures provided in this report for the years 1967 to 1970 are estimates and, therefore, should not be construed as having the same reliability as population counts from the census. Though the estimates have been produced and revised by well established and tested statistical procedures, important differences do occur among provinces; this is partly due to the varying quality of the symptomatic series data available from each of the provinces which form the basis of estimation.

In order to facilitate appraisals of the changes which the county and census division populations have undergone, this report also provides, in each case, components of change due to natural increase and migration. The natural increase component consists of births minus deaths and the net migration component represents the difference between total increase and natural increase (i.e., the "residual").

### ESTIMATIONS RÉVISÉES DE LA POPULATION PAR COMTÉ ET PAR DIVISION DE RECENSEMENT

Le présent bulletin contient les estimations démographiques révisées des 223 comtés et divisions de recensement de 1967 à 1970 et combine les livraisons annuelles du Catalogue 91-206. Les estimations rendent compte de toutes les provinces canadiennes mais n'en englobent cependant ni le Yukon ni les Territoires du Nord-Ouest.

Les chiffres se rapportent à la population au 1er juin de chaque année. Cette date coïncide avec celle des recensements décennaux et quinquennaux, ainsi qu'avec celle des estimations annuelles postcensitaires de la population du Canada et des provinces.

La méthodologie de cette révision est la même que celle de la révision des estimations par province. Elle consiste à répartir progressivement sur les années 1967 à 1970 la différence entre l'estimation pour 1971 et les totaux du dénombrement de 1971 dans chaque comté et division de recensement. Si nous supposons que 'd' représente la différence pour un comté ou une division de recensement entre les données du dénombrement de 1971 et l'estimation de 1971, nous ajoutons alors  $d/5$  à l'estimation de 1967,  $2d/5$  à l'estimation de 1968 et ainsi de suite. Ainsi, on tient essentiellement compte des ajustements que nécessitent les différences entre les taux de croissance et de décroissance démographique dans chaque comté ou division de recensement pendant la période quinquennale 1966 à 1971. On a toutefois rajusté le total révisé de tous les comtés et divisions de recensement d'une même province de façon à ce qu'il corresponde au total révisé pour cette même province d'après les estimations annuelles par province. Le bulletin de 1967 (Catalogue 91-206) expose en détail la méthodologie utilisée pour parvenir aux estimations postcensitaires non révisées pour ce qui est des comtés et des divisions de recensement de chaque province.

Comme on l'a souligné dans les bulletins précédents, les chiffres présentés pour les années 1967 à 1970 ne sont que des estimations et par conséquent on ne doit pas leur attribuer une fiabilité comparable à celle du recensement de la population. Bien que les estimations soient établies et révisées à l'aide de procédés statistiques reconnus et éprouvés, on constate cependant des différences notables d'une province à l'autre, entre le recensement et les estimations, différences qu'explique en partie la qualité variable des données des séries statistiques symptomatiques fournies par chacune des provinces et qui forment la base de l'estimation.

Afin de faciliter l'évaluation des changements démographiques dont les comtés et les divisions de recensement ont été l'objet, ce bulletin présente aussi dans chaque cas les composantes de l'évolution démographique soit: l'accroissement naturel et la migration. L'"accroissement naturel" représente la différence entre les naissances et les décès tandis que la "migration nette" est la différence entre l'accroissement total et l'accroissement naturel (c'est-à-dire qu'il s'agit du nombre "résiduel").
