

Introduction

For years other than census years, Statistics Canada produces **postcensal estimates** of the population by marital status as of June 1. After each census, these estimates are revised in order to provide **intercensal estimates** compatible with the results of the censuses at the beginning and end of the period in question.

This bulletin, the first in a series, contains **intercensal estimates** of the population by sex and marital status, in quinquennial age groups from 15 years to 90 years and over, as of June 1 of the years 1972 to 1975. The census data of June 1, 1971 and 1976 are also included to facilitate comparisons. Intercensal estimates of the population by marital status for 1966 to 1971 and for 1961 to 1966 have previously been published in the editions of Catalogue 91-203 for the year following a census year (see the References in this publication). Henceforth, Catalogue 91-203 will be devoted solely to the postcensal estimates of the population by marital status.

METHODOLOGY

By definition, intercensal estimates are based on the assumption that the numbers produced are compatible with the data of the two censuses which envelop the period in question. This implies that the trends in the intercensal estimates are also compatible with census data when the population is broken down by marital status, age and sex, regardless of the level of detail being considered.

The methodology which was used to produce these intercensal estimates generated the required compatible results in two stages:

1. First, intercensal estimates were produced by sex and age. For the most part this means that, for each birth cohort, the error observed at the end of the period between the postcensal estimates as of June 1, 1976 and the 1976 Census data, is distributed among the five postcensal estimates for the years 1972 to 1976.¹

Introduction

Sauf pour les années de recensement, Statistique Canada produit des **estimations postcensitaires** de la population selon l'état matrimonial au 1^{er} juin. Après chaque recensement, ces estimations sont révisées dans le but d'obtenir des **estimations intercensitaires** compatibles avec les résultats des deux recensements encadrant la période considérée.

Le présent bulletin, qui est le premier de sa série, contient les **estimations intercensitaires** de la population selon le sexe et l'état matrimonial, par groupes d'âges quinquennaux de 15 ans à 90 ans et plus, aux 1^{er} juin des années 1972 à 1975. Les effectifs recensés les 1^{er} juin 1971 et 1976 sont également inclus afin de faciliter les comparaisons. Pour les périodes antérieures à celle de 1971 à 1976, les estimations intercensitaires de la population selon l'état matrimonial paraissaient dans l'édition de la publication n° 91-203 au catalogue qui suivait une année de recensement (voir la section des références). Cette dernière publication (n° 91-203 au catalogue) sera désormais uniquement consacrée aux estimations postcensitaires de la population selon l'état matrimonial.

MÉTHODOLOGIE

Par définition les estimations intercensitaires presupposent que les nombres produits sont compatibles avec les données des deux recensements encadrant la période considérée. Pour les estimations intercensitaires de la population selon l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe, ceci implique que l'évolution des effectifs est aussi compatible lorsque l'on éclate la population selon l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe et ce, quelle que soit la finesse des recouplements.

La méthodologie qui a été utilisée afin de produire ces estimations intercensitaires génère la compatibilité nécessaire en deux étapes.

1. Premièrement, par l'ajustement au niveau du sexe et de l'âge, c'est-à-dire par la production des estimations intercensitaires de la population selon le sexe et l'âge. Dans ses grandes lignes, il s'agissait, pour chaque génération, de répartir l'erreur observée en fin de période entre les estimations postcensitaires au 1^{er} juin 1976 et le recensement de 1976, dans les cinq estimations postcensitaires de la période 1972 à 1976¹.

2. In the second step, marital status categories were assigned to the intercensal numbers which were obtained in the preceding step. This was done in two stages:

by imputing the percentage distribution of the population by marital status for each age and sex group as of June 1 of each year from 1972 to 1975; and,

by applying these percentages to the age-sex estimates which were obtained above, so as to obtain intercensal estimates by age and sex for each marital status category.

For a given sex and age, the following definitions are:

ER^t : the number of persons in the census of year t ;
 jER^t : the number of persons of marital status j in the census of year t ;
 jPR^t : the proportion of the population of marital status j in the census of year t ;
 $EIt + i$: the number of persons in the intercensal year $t + i$;
 $jEIt + i$: the number of persons of marital status j in the intercensal year $t + i$;
 $jPIt + i$: the proportion of the population of marital status j in the intercensal year $t + i$;
 j : marital status:
 S = single
 M = married
 W = widowed
 D = divorced.

For each province, the proportional distribution by marital status for each sex and age was calculated for the two census years:

$$jPR1971 = jER1971 / ER1971, \text{ for } j = S, M, W, D;$$
$$jPR1976 = jER1976 / ER1976, \text{ for } j = S, M, W, D.$$

The proportional distribution for the intercensal years were estimated by apportioning equally over the five years 1971-72 to 1975-76 the five-year trend associated with a given age-sex category.

The intercensal population estimates by marital status were ultimately obtained by breaking down the

2. Deuxièmement, par l'attribution d'états matrimoniaux aux effectifs intercensitaires obtenus à l'étape 1. Ce calcul a été réalisé en deux phases:

pour un âge et un sexe donnés, on a estimé les répartitions en pourcentage de la population suivant l'état matrimonial, aux 1er juin des années 1972 à 1975;

ensuite on a éclaté les estimations produites à l'étape 1 en quatre états matrimoniaux, à l'aide des répartitions estimées ci-dessus.

HIGHLIGHTS

As of June 1, 1976, there were 17,096,425 persons or 74.4% of Canada's total population 15 years of age and over, compared with 15,187,415 or 70.4% as of June 1, 1971. The large increase in the relative importance of this group stems from the fact that it increased during the intercensal period by 1,909,010, or 12.6%, while the number of persons under 15 years of age decreased by 484,720, or - 7.6%. This can be largely explained by the decline in the birth rate during the last 15 years.

According to the June 1, 1976 Census, there were 8,429,510 males 15 years of age and over of which 31.4% were single, 64.9% were married, 2.3% were widowed and 1.4% were divorced. There was a slightly higher number of females (8,666,915) in the same age group who were enumerated in the 1976 Census, of which 24.6% were single, 63.5% were married, 9.9% were widowed and 2.1% were divorced. This distribution differs only slightly from the data for the 1971 Census. The percentage of single and of widowed males dropped in both cases by 0.2%, whereas the percentage of divorced males increased by 0.4%. The percentage of single and of married females decreased in both cases by 0.4%, while that of divorced females increased by 0.8% (Text Table I).

Between June 1, 1971 and June 1, 1976, the number of divorced persons increased by 82.1% among females and by 60.1% among males. The number of widows increased by 13.4% while the number of widowers decreased by 0.8%. The number of married females increased by 12.5% and married males by 12.0%. At the same time, the number of single persons increased by 11.3% for both males and females.

Marital Status and Age Group

Table 2 (page 40) shows the proportion of single, married, widowed and divorced persons in Canada by age group and sex in 1971 and 1976. During this period, for both sexes and in almost all age groups, there was a decrease in the proportion of single persons and widowed persons and an increase in the proportion of divorced persons. The most notable exceptions were the increase in the proportion of single males and females in the 20 to 29 age groups, and the increase in the proportion of widows over 75

TRAITS SAILLANTS

Au 1^{er} juin 1976, 17,096,425 personnes étaient âgées de 15 ans et plus, soit 74.4 % de la population totale du Canada, comparativement à 15,187,415 ou 70.4 % au 1^{er} juin 1971. Cette forte hausse du poids des 15 ans et plus provient du fait que leur nombre a augmenté au cours de la période intercensitaire de 1,909,010 (ou 12.6 %) tandis que l'effectif de la population âgée de moins de 15 ans a diminué de 484,720 (ou - 7.6 %). Cette dernière situation s'explique surtout par la baisse de la natalité depuis les 15 dernières années.

Le recensement du 1^{er} juin 1976 a dénombré 8,429,510 hommes âgés de 15 ans et plus dont 31.4 % de célibataires, 64.9 % de mariés, 2.3 % de veufs et 1.4 % de divorcés. Le nombre de femmes de 15 ans et plus recensées à cette même date est légèrement plus élevé, soit 8,666,915 dont 24.6 % de célibataires, 63.5 % de mariées, 9.9 % de veuves et 2.1 % de divorcées. Par rapport aux données du recensement de 1971, ces répartitions n'ont que très légèrement changé. Pour les hommes, les pourcentages de célibataires et de veufs ont diminué de 0.2 % au profit du pourcentage de divorcés qui a augmenté de 0.4 %. Pour les femmes, les pourcentages des célibataires et de mariées ont diminué de 0.4 % et celui des divorcées a augmenté de 0.8 % (tableau explicatif I).

Entre les 1^{er} juin 1971 et 1976, les effectifs de divorcés ont augmenté de 82.1 % chez les femmes et de 60.1 % chez les hommes. Le nombre de femmes en veuvage s'est accru de 13.4 % tandis que chez les hommes il y a eu diminution de 0.8 %. Pour les mariés, on a enregistré des augmentations de 12.5 % chez les femmes et 12.0 % chez les hommes. Enfin les effectifs de célibataires se sont accrus de 11.3 % chez les hommes et chez les femmes.

Etat matrimonial et groupe d'âges

Le tableau 2 (page 40) présente pour le Canada, les proportions de célibataires, mariés, veufs et divorcés selon le groupe d'âges et le sexe, en 1971 et 1976. Au cours de cette période, on enregistre dans les deux sexes et à presque tous les groupes d'âges, une diminution de la proportion de célibataires, une diminution de la proportion de veufs et une augmentation de la proportion de divorcés. Les deux exceptions les plus remarquées sont l'augmentation des proportions des hommes et des femmes célibataires chez les 20 à 29 ans, et l'augmentation de la proportion de veuves au-dessus de 75 ans. years of age. The trends among married persons were much less uniform. There was an increase in the proportion of married females in the age groups 15 to 19 and 50 to 74 years and a decrease in the age groups 20 to 49 and 75 and over. The proportion of married males increased in the age groups 35 to 49 and 55 and over while it decreased in the age groups 25 to 34 and 50 to 54 years. Figure I shows the trends in the proportion of single, married, widowed and divorced persons by age group and sex as of June 1, 1976.

Sex Ratio

The sex ratios in Table 3 show the disparities between the number of males and females within the marital status category.

There were 124.3 single males for every 100 single females in the population 15 years of age and over as of June 1, 1976. This large proportion of males stems mainly from the fact that among single


Les rapports de masculinité du tableau 3 font voir l'ampleur des inégalités qui existent entre les effectifs masculins et féminins au sein d'un même état matrimonial.

persons less than 30 years of age, females on the average marry at an earlier age and in a higher proportion than do males. Even though after age 30 single males have higher marriage and mortality rates than females, it is only after age 55 when there are more single women than men (see Figure II). Beyond that age, the number of single persons is so small that the larger number of females in these older age groups cannot compensate for the larger number of males among persons under 30 years of age.²

Among the married population, the total number of males and females was practically equal, at 99.5 males for every 100 females. However, the sex ratios for the youngest and oldest age groups are far from equal (25:100 in the 15 to 19 age group and 274:100 in the 85 to 89 age group).

The ratios are very low among the widowed at all ages. The average ratio is 22.2 males for every 100 females. This can be attributed not only to the higher death rate among males, but also to the fact that on the average females marry at an earlier age than their husbands, and that after widowhood they have a lower rate of remarriage than men.

The sex ratio of divorced persons for all ages is 64.9:100. Here also, this low ratio can be attributed to the fact that divorced females have a lower rate of remarriage than divorced males, and that there is an age difference between spouses and to the higher death rate for males.

RELIABILITY OF THE ESTIMATES

The estimates in this publication are subject to a certain margin of error, some of which stem from errors in census data and some of which stem from the estimation methodology employed.

Errors from census figures include coverage errors and response and processing errors.

Coverage errors are mainly caused by under-enumeration. Since over-enumeration is fairly rare, it is considered negligible. In Canada, the total undercoverage rate was practically the same in the 1971 and 1976 Censuses, about 2%. However, Text Table II shows that it was unevenly distributed by marital status.

femmes se marient en moyenne plus jeunes et en proportion plus élevée que les hommes de ce groupe d'âges. Même si après 30 ans les hommes célibataires ont des taux de mariage et de mortalité supérieurs à ceux des femmes, ces taux ne réussissent pas à compenser avant 55 ans le retard déjà acquis (voir la figure II). Au delà de cet âge, les effectifs mis en cause sont alors si petits qu'ils ne font pas le poids devant ceux mis en cause avant 30 ans².

À la même date, les nombres totaux d'hommes et de femmes mariés étaient pratiquement égaux, 99.5 hommes pour 100 femmes. On peut cependant voir qu'aux deux extrémités d'âge, les rapports de masculinité sont loin du point d'équilibre (25: 100 chez les 15 à 19 ans et 274: 100 chez les 85 à 89 ans).

Chez les veufs on note des rapports très faibles à tous les âges, en moyenne 22.2 hommes pour 100 femmes. On peut attribuer cela non seulement à la surmortalité masculine, mais aussi au fait que les femmes sont en moyenne plus jeunes que leur mari et ont un taux de remariage suite au veuvage inférieur à celui des hommes.

Le rapport de masculinité tous âges des divorcés est de 64.9:100. Ici aussi, cette faible masculinité peut être attribuée au fait que les divorcées ont des taux de remariage inférieurs aux divorcés, au décalage d'âge entre les époux et à la surmortalité masculine.

LIMITATIONS DES NOMBRES ESTIMÉS

Les nombres contenus dans la présente publication sont entachés d'une certaine marge d'imprécision qui provient à la fois des erreurs dues aux données des recensements et des erreurs dues aux méthodologies d'estimation.

Les erreurs provenant des chiffres des recensements comprennent des erreurs de couverture et des erreurs de réponse et d'exploitation.


Les erreurs de couverture sont principalement causées par un sous-dénombrément. Le surdénombrément étant assez rare, il est considéré comme négligeable. Au niveau du Canada, le taux global du sous-dénombrément fut pratiquement le même dans les recensements de 1971 et 1976, environ 2 %. Le tableau explicatif II montre que le sous-dénombrément était cependant inégalement réparti selon l'état matrimonial.





The main response and processing errors stem from non-responses, misinterpretation of questions by the respondents and coding and imputation errors. The response rate for the 1976 Census question on age was 98.4%, on marital status 98.0% and on sex 98.6%. Although it is difficult to measure the significance of the errors which stem from the estimation methods and from data sources other than the censuses, they probably are not negligible. At each level of detail additional inaccuracy is introduced. The intercensal population estimates by sex and age themselves contain errors, and the method which was used to attribute marital status categories to them adds a new source of error. The significance of this error is certainly greater in age groups where the distribution by marital status varies markedly (for example, ages 15 to 34) than in age groups where it is fairly stable (for example, ages 35 to 54).

Finally, the accuracy of the figures is also affected by the very definition of marital status. In Canadian censuses, all persons living in common-

law arrangements are considered to be married.³ The estimates contained in the present publication employ the same definition. There is reason to believe that this practice causes a significant transfer to the married category from other marital status categories. For example, there were 74,355 divorced males in Canada as of June 1, 1971. Although the occurrence of demographic events between June 1, 1971 and June 1, 1976 would lead one to expect a total of approximately 170,000⁴ divorced males as of June 1, 1976, there were only 119,035 such persons enumerated in the 1976 Census.

DEFINITIONS

Population

Estimated population and population according to the census are both defined as being "the total number of persons whose usual place of residence . . . was somewhere in Canada, including Canadian government employees stationed abroad and their families, members of Canadian Armed Forces stationed abroad and their families, and crews of Canadian merchant vessels. Not included are government representatives of other countries and their families, attached to the legation, embassy, or other diplomatic body of that country, members of the Armed Forces of other countries stationed in Canada and members of their families who are not citizens of Canada, students attending school in Canada whose usual residence is outside Canada, and residents of another country visiting in Canada temporarily". (*Dictionary of the 1971 Census Terms*, Catalogue 12-540, page 28.)

Postcensal Estimate

Population estimate produced by using data from the most recent census and estimates of the components of demographic change since that last census date.

Intercensal Estimate

Population estimate derived by using data from the censuses preceding and following the year in question.

Error of Closure

Difference between the population according to a census and the updated postcensal estimate for the same date.

Population

Estimation postcensitaire

Estimation de l'effectif de la population obtenue en utilisant les résultats du dernier recensement disponible et l'estimation des composantes du changement démographique survenu depuis la date de ce dernier recensement.

Estimation intercensitaire

Estimation de l'effectif de la population obtenue en tenant compte des résultats des deux recensements encadrant l'année considérée.

Erreur en fin de période intercensitaire

Différence entre la population donnée par un recensement et l'estimation postcensitaire corrigée à la date du recensement.

Undercoverage Rate

The ratio, expressed in percentage, of the number of persons not enumerated in the census (who were intended to have been enumerated in that census) to the total number that should have been enumerated in the census.

Sex Ratio (or Masculinity, Ratio)

The ratio of the number of men to the number of women. This is not to be confused with the sex ratio at birth, which is the ratio of the number of live boys born to the number of live girls born. This ratio is usually expressed as an index, with the number of women taken to be a base of 100.

Marital Status

Indicates the conjugal status, that is, whether single, married widowed or divorced. Please note that:

Single. Includes persons who have never been married and all persons under 15 years of age.

Married. Includes persons now married, separated (legally or otherwise) persons who are not divorced and persons living in common-law unions.

Taux de sous-dénombrement

Rapport, exprimé en pourcentage, du nombre des personnes qui n'ont pas été recensées (mais étaient visées par le recensement) à celui de l'ensemble des personnes visées par le recensement.

Rapport de masculinité

Rapport de l'effectif du sexe masculin à l'effectif du sexe féminin. Le rapport de masculinité à la naissance désigne le rapport des naissances masculines aux naissances féminines. On exprime généralement ce rapport comme un indice, l'effectif du sexe féminin étant pris pour base 100.

État matrimonial

Indique la situation conjugale, c'est-à-dire célibataire, marié, veuf et divorcé. Il convient de signaler que:

Célibataire. Comprend les personnes qui n'ont jamais été mariées et toutes les personnes de moins de 15 ans.

Marié. Comprend les personnes actuellement mariées, les personnes séparées légalement ou non mais qui n'ont pas obtenu de divorce et les personnes vivant en union consensuelle.
