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# THE YEAR OF IMMIGRATION, PLACE OF BIRTH AND NATURALIZATION

OF THE

## FOREIGN-BORN RESIDENT IN CANADA,

JUNE, 1911.

This special Report deals with the year of immigration, nativity and citizenship of the foreign-born in Canada at the date of the Census, June, 1911. The statistics are abstracted from the records of the Fifth Census. The following extracts from the Manual of Instructions to enumerators will give an idea of the general principles followed in making the record, from which the statistics of this report have been tabulated:—

**Birthplace.** "If the person was born outside of Canada the enumerator will enter the name of the country in which he or she was born."

"In the case of persons born in the double Kingdom of Austria-Hungary, care should be taken to give the particular provinces, as Austria, Tyrol, Bohemia, Moravia, Silesia, Galicia, etc."

"In the case of persons, who say they were born in Poland which is no longer an independent country, inquiry should be made whether the birthplace was in what is now known as German Poland, or Austrian Poland or Russian Poland, and the answer should be written accordingly, as German (Pol.), Austrian (Pol.), or Russian (Pol.). If the birthplace given is Turkey, the enumerator should ask whether European or Asiatic Turkey and write Turkey (E.) or Turkey (A.), accordingly."

**Year of Immigration to Canada.**—"This question applies to all persons irrespective of age or sex who were born outside of Canada. . . . and the year of their first entry into Canada should be given."

**Year of Naturalization.**—"This question applies only to persons 21 years old and over who were born in some other country than the United Kingdom or any of its dependencies"

The instructions, regarding naturalization were based on the Canadian Naturalization Act and were made to apply only to persons 21 years old and over who were born in some other country than the United Kingdom or any of its dependencies. The status of children, of parents who had obtained Canadian citizenship, was governed by the section of the Naturalization law respecting minors, which provides "If the father, or the mother being a widow, has obtained a certificate of naturalization within Canada, every child of such father or mother within Canada, shall, within Canada, be deemed to be a naturalized British subject." The question of the citizenship of children of naturalized parents will be referred to later on. The inquiry regarding immigration was designed to show what proportion of the foreign-born immigrants of each year or period of years, was living in the country June 1, 1911, and where they were located, while that concerning naturalization was designed to show the citizenship of this class of the population of Canada.

The statistics resulting from these inquiries are presented for Canada as a whole, for each of the provinces and for cities of 15,000 inhabitants and over in Tables 1 to 23.

The total number of foreign-born in Canada, June, 1911, was 752,732, of whom 470,927 or 62.6 per cent were males and 281,805 or 37.4 per cent were females. Of the males foreign-born, living in Canada at the date of the census, 124,404 or 26.4 per cent were under 21 years of age and therefore incapable of making a voluntary choice of citizenship. The year of arrival in Canada was not reported for 63,563 persons of alien birth—37,963 males and 25,600 females. Consequently the number of arrivals in each year or period of years cannot be definitely stated.

The figures of Table 1, which gives the total foreign-born in Canada classified by sex and year of immigration, show that of the foreign-born with year of arrival reported (689,169) and resident in Canada at the date of the last census, June, 1911, 528,066 or 76.6 per cent had come to Canada since 1901. It is, therefore a reasonable assumption that the major portion, if not all of those for whom the year of immigration was not reported (63,563), had also come to Canada in the ten years immediately preceding the Fifth decennial census. In every 1,000 persons of foreign birth resident in Canada June, 1911, 626 were males and 374 females, as compared with 507 males and 493 females in every 1,000 persons of Canadian birth. A further significant fact of alien immigration is, that the proportion of males to females has steadily increased in each successive year and quinquennium since 1890. Of the total foreign-born immigrants of 1890 and previous years, resident in Canada June, 1911, 56.6 per cent were males as against 58.8 per cent for those of the 1891-1895 period, 59.1 per cent for those of the 1896-1900 period, 60.9 per cent for those of the period 1901-1905 and 65.8 per cent for those of the period 1906 to June, 1911.

Table 2 gives the number of foreign-born in Canada and in each of the provinces, classified according to year of arrival in Canada. For example, of the total number (105,097) of foreign-born in British Columbia 55,451 immigrated in 1906-1911, 17,842 in 1901-1905, 12,009 in 1896-1900, 5,102 in 1891-1895, 7,924 previous to 1891 and 6,769 for whom the year of arrival in Canada was not reported. No provision was made in the census schedules, supplied to the enumerators in the Yukon and Northwest Territories for recording the year of immigration or of naturalization of the foreign-born population.

Table 3 gives for the foreign-born, with year of immigration reported, the per cent distribution according to years of arrival in Canada, by provinces. It also shows the per cent proportion of the immigrants in each province for whom the year of arrival was (1) reported and (2) not reported. The year of immigration is omitted from the enumerators record for 35.41 per cent of the foreign-born resident in New Brunswick, for 25.01 per cent in Nova Scotia, for 18.94 per cent in Quebec, for 18.24 per cent in Prince Edward Island. In none of the western provinces did the omission from the record, of the year of arrival in Canada, reach  $6\frac{1}{2}$  per cent. For British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Ontario and Nova Scotia more than 50 per cent of the total foreign-born residents in these provinces were immigrants of the years 1906-1911. The proportion of immigrants who came to Canada previous to 1891 was greatest in New Brunswick (24.27 per cent), Ontario (20.07 per cent), Prince Edward Island (14.04 per cent) and Quebec (12.37 per cent). In this table the figures for the Yukon and the Northwest Territories are omitted from the calculations. The table is to be read horizontally and shows, for example, that of the total foreign-born in British Columbia 56.39 per cent had come to Canada in the

years 1906-June, 1911, 18.15 per cent in 1901-1905, 12.21 per cent in 1896-1900, 5.19 per cent in 1891-1895 and 8.06 per cent in the years prior to 1891.

Table 4 gives the per cent distribution of the total foreign-born who have come to Canada in each period of years, by provinces. The table is to be read vertically and shows that of the total foreign-born (752,732) in Canada June, 1911, 13.96 per cent (105,097) were located in British Columbia, 18.96 per cent (142,711) in Alberta, 21.60 per cent (162,610) in Saskatchewan, 12.71 per cent (95,688) in Manitoba, 19.76 per cent (148,764) in Ontario, 9.89 per cent (74,421) in Quebec, 1.08 per cent (8,134) in New Brunswick, 1.46 per cent (10,972) in Nova Scotia and less than one-half of one per cent (932) in Prince Edward Island, (3,316) in the Yukon and (87) in the Northwest Territories. It must be borne in mind that the province of residence of the foreign-born at the date of the census, June, 1911, may not have been their province of first location. The question of the supply of and demand for labour determines in a large measure the tenure of residence in any locality of the industrial and labouring classes, particularly of immigrants.

Of the total foreign-born, 67.2 per cent resided in the western provinces; and grouping the foreign immigration by quinquennial periods, it will be found that of those arriving in the years 1906-1911 more than 70 per cent resided west of the Great Lakes, of those of the years 1901-1905 about 75 per cent, of those of the years 1896-1900 75.6 per cent, and of those of the years 1891-1895 over 65 per cent. Beginning with the five year period 1896-1900, Saskatchewan has claimed the greatest proportion of the foreign immigrants, followed by Alberta in all years excepting 1896-1900, when Manitoba came second with 19.75 per cent. Of the foreign-born immigrants of 1906-1911 (360,524) Saskatchewan became the residence of 83,560 or 23.18 per cent, Alberta of 80,509 or 22.23

per cent and Ontario of 71,239 or 19.76 per cent, British Columbia of 55,451 or 15.38 per cent, Manitoba of 35,040 or 9.72 per cent and Quebec of 27,849 or 7.72 per cent. That comparatively few foreigners locate in the Maritime provinces, is shown by the fact that of the total in Canada, New Brunswick had only 1.08 per cent, Nova Scotia 1.46 per cent and Prince Edward Island .12 per cent. The percentage of foreign immigration locating in the provinces of Quebec and Manitoba has steadily decreased for every five year period since 1890, while for the years previous to 1896 foreign immigrants were found in greater numbers in Ontario than elsewhere in Canada.

The number of the foreign-born classified according to country of birth, by year of arrival in Canada, is given in Table 5, while Table 6 gives the percentage which the immigrants from each alien country formed of the total foreign-born population arriving in Canada in each period of years. Of the total foreign-born (752,732) in Canada at the date of the census, 404,941 or 53.79 per cent were born in European countries, 303,680 or 40.34 per cent were born in the United States and 40,946 or 5.45 per cent in Asiatic countries. In comparing the percentage of immigrants received from European and Asiatic countries with those who came from the United States, it is well to bear in mind that the immigrants coming to Canada from the latter country include many races (see Table 15, page 31), while those credited to the various other alien countries represent usually a distinctive racial type. Austro-Hungarians, comprising Austrians (67,502), Bohemians (1,689), Bukovinians (10,280), Galicians (31,373), Hungarians (10,586), were nearly 30 per cent of all European (continental) born residents of Canada in 1911 and more than 16 per cent of all foreign-born immigrants. Russia, including Finland, supplied 100,971 or 13.41 per cent of all the foreign born living in Canada, June, 1911, Norway and Sweden 49,194 or 6.53 per cent, Germany 39,577 or 5.27 per cent, Italy 34,739 or 4.60 per cent, France 17,619 or 2.34 per cent, Bulgaria and Roumania 9,657 or 2.11 per cent,

other countries of Europe 31,754 or 4.21 per cent. Of the immigrants born in Asia and residing in Canada more than two-thirds of the total were born in China.

The following were in order of rank the seven leading countries, with respect of the number contributed to the foreign-born population of Canada as reported in the censuses of 1911 and 1901 respectively:—

The list of countries was the same at each census, but the rank of each country changed, except the United States, which occupied first place at each decennial period.

In the census of 1901 the number of persons who were reported as born in the United States and living in Canada exceeded the total number of immigrants from continental Europe living at the date of the census March 31, by 2,350, whereas by the census of 1911 the European born residents of Canada exceeded those born in the United States by 101,261.

For all periods, excepting 1896-1900, the United States ranked first in respect to the proportion of immigrants contributed and resident in Canada June, 1911, when first place was taken by Austria-Hungary. Denmark and France each secured a place among the seven highest contributors to the foreign-born population of Canada—the former in regard to immigrants of the period prior to 1891 and the latter to those whose years of immigration were between 1891 and 1895. Germany dropped from second rank in the period before 1891 to fourth place in 1891-1895, to fifth place in 1896-1900 and to sixth place in the two subsequent periods. It will be noticed that the number of immigrants from China residing in Canada ranked that country as the sixth greatest source of the foreign-born population of the Dominion and compared by periods of years, only in the last did it occupy seventh place.

The two preceding tables show, that of the foreign-born (63,563) with year of immigration not reported, 59.42 per cent (37,768) were born in the United States, 35 per cent (22,249) in Europe, and nearly 5 per cent (2,922) in Asia. In other words the census records as regards years of arrival in Canada was defective for 12.4 per cent of the immigrants born in the United States, for 7.1 per cent of those born in Asia and for 5.5 per cent of those born in the countries of Europe. The following statement calculated from Table 5 shows the proportion of the foreign-born population of Canada, 1911, by specified countries, for whom the year of arrival in Canada was wanting.

Table 7 gives the numerical and per cent distribution of the foreign-born population, classified according to country of birth by provinces, June, 1911. The table also combines the totals by numbers and percentages for the western and the maritime provinces. There being only 3,403 persons of alien birth in the Yukon and Northwest Territories, the percentages, owing to the smallness of the numbers supplied by each foreign country specified, have not been worked out.

The western provinces became the residence of 97·82 per cent of the population born in Iceland, 97·51 per cent of that born in Japan, 85·54 per cent of that born in Norway and Sweden, 83·47 per cent of that born in China, 82·80 per cent of that born in Austria-Hungary, 75·44 per cent of that born in Holland, 75·31 per cent of that born in Denmark, 67·46 per cent of that born in the United States, 67·28 per cent of that born in Belgium, from 50 to 65 per cent of that born in Russia (including Finland), Germany and France, and from 30 to 38 per cent of that born in Roumania, Greece and Italy and of less than 20 per cent of that born in Turkey and Bulgaria. It is interesting to observe that those foreigners, who have settled in greater numbers in eastern Canada than in the western provinces, immigrated from countries of southeastern Europe and usually represent peoples whose avocations are conducted in urban centres. More than one-half of the total foreign-born population in the maritime provinces claimed the United States as their country of origin, being 89 per cent in Prince Edward Island, 71 per cent in New Brunswick and 41 per cent in Nova Scotia. In Ontario more than 37 per cent of the foreign-born population was born in the United States, in Quebec more than 40 per cent, in Alberta 57 per cent and in Saskatchewan nearly 43 per cent.

No persons born in Iceland or Japan were reported in New Brunswick or Prince Edward Island, the latter province had no persons reported as born in Austria-Hungary, Belgium, Bulgaria, Denmark, Finland, Greece or Roumania.

Considering the distribution of the foreign-born by provinces, Ontario had the greatest number of persons born in Finland, (6,871 or 62·54 per cent of the total), in Bulgaria (1,020 or 61·22 per cent) in Turkey and Syria (2,297 or 48·18 per cent), in Italy (16,411 or 47·24 per cent), in Greece (1,119 or 42·39 per cent,) and in Germany (15,010 or 37·93 per cent). Quebec had the greatest number of persons born in Roumania, 3,697 or 46·27 per cent, and in France 5,928 or 37·93 per cent. Manitoba and the Maritime provinces possessed the fewest number of persons born in the United States, being 16,326 or 5·38 per cent of the total for the former and 11,397 or 3·75 per cent for the latter, while Alberta and Saskatchewan had the greatest numbers, being 81,357 or 26·70 per cent for the former and 69,628 or 22·93 per cent for the latter.

Nearly 70 per cent of all persons born in Japan and 69½ per cent of those born in China were residents of British Columbia. Natives of Austria-Hungary are found in greatest numbers in Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta and Ontario, in the order named.

Table 8 presents for Canada, as a whole, a summary of the foreign-born classified by years of immigration and citizenship. Of the total number with year of immigration reported 52.31 per cent came to Canada in the years 1905-June, 1911, and of this number 80,084 or 22.21 per cent had assumed Canadian citizenship, while 77.79 per cent were of alien nationality. But it must be remembered that 202,159, or more than 56 per cent of the 1906-1911 arrivals, were not long enough in the country to give effective expression to their desire for Canadian citizenship. In this report only those of alien birth, who had completed the legal processes necessary for naturalization, are regarded as citizens. Table XXVI, Volume 11, of the last census places the number of the naturalized population at 353,588 as compared with 344,557 in this bulletin, the difference (9,031) represents those who had taken the first steps towards naturalization, but had not, at the time of the census, secured the status of citizenship either for themselves or their dependents.

Notwithstanding the fact that the naturalization law of Canada requires a three years residence in the country before an alien is entitled to obtain the privileges of citizenship, yet the table shows that 12,736 persons who came to

Canada in 1909-1911 were naturalized. This discrepancy is more apparent than real. Table 11, page 19, states that of the arrivals of 1909-June, 1911, who were naturalized, only 133 were males 21 years of age and over, at the date of the census or less than one-tenth of one per cent of the total male immigrants of foreign birth whose residence in Canada was less than three years, the remaining 12,603 of this period represent the foreign-born females and children under 21 years of age who became naturalized as a result of action taken by husband or parent (see section of Act previously quoted, page 5). That is to say, husbands or parents had come to Canada previous to bringing wives and children, the latter, although being in the country less than three years, participated in the benefits of citizenship automatically in consequence of the naturalization of the head of the house.

Of the total foreign-born with years of immigration reported 29.3 per cent came to Canada in the years 1909-June, 1911, while the foreign-born arrivals of the five years 1906-1911 made up more than 52 per cent of the total foreign-born living in Canada at the date of the Fifth Census. Of the foreign-born whose year of immigration was not reported 51.56 per cent were naturalized.

Table 9 gives the number of immigrants, both sexes, from each specified foreign country, classified by years of arrival in Canada, who have become naturalized. Table 10 gives the same information by percentages. The numbers and percentages of the foreign-born naturalized, for the period 1906-June, 1911, as compared with the other specified quinquennial periods are adversely affected by the immigrants of the years 1909-10 and the four months of 1911, who, because of shortness of time in the country, could not obtain naturalization.

Of the total foreign-born, whose year of immigration was previous to 1891, nearly 72 per cent had become Canadian citizens prior to the taking of the Fifth census of Canada. Of the immigrants of the years 1891-1895 over 75 per cent were naturalized, of those of the years 1896-1900 69.45 per cent, and of those of the years 1901-1905 nearly 70 per cent, while of those arriving in the five years and five months immediately preceding the last census only 22.21 per cent were naturalized. But of the last mentioned, only 158,365 out of 360,524 had been in Canada for a longer period than three years, that is, were immigrants of the years 1906-1908 and of these 67,347 or 42.52 per cent were naturalized.

Tables 9 and 10 further show by country of origin the alien born who have most readily become naturalized. Natives of Iceland lead with 82.48 per cent followed by those of Germany with 50.57 per cent, of Austria-Hungary with 50.19 per cent, of the United States with 49.99 per cent, of Denmark with 47.78 per cent, of Roumania with 46.09 per cent, of Russia with 45.52 per cent. Of the Italian, Greek and Asiatic born less than 20 per cent have naturalized. In both tables immigrants from Iceland and Finland are not included with Denmark and Russia, but are given separately. The tables afford an

opportunity of observing how the immigrants from each specified country, for each immigration period recorded, had become naturalized. The percentages in table 10 are worked from tables 5 and 9.

Table 11 classifies the foreign-born males of voting age according to citizenship and years of immigration, for Canada as a whole and for each of the provinces. Statistics for the Yukon and Northwest Territories are not included in this table. On page 14 reference was made to immigrants of alien birth of less than three years residence in the Dominion who were reported as having obtained naturalization. The figures of Table 11 show that only a small proportion of these (133 out of a total of 12,736) were males of voting age at the date of the census. The fact that these 133 males of voting age, whose period of residence in Canada was less than three years, were naturalized does not mean that the law was over-reached. These persons, although 21 years of age at the date of the census, may have been minors at the time of their first arrival in Canada and would therefore, as regards citizenship, be controlled by the action of the parents (see page 5). Of the 133 males thus reported 96 of them were born in the United States and were located in British Columbia (20), Alberta (20), Saskatchewan (15), Manitoba (7), Ontario (21), Quebec (9), New Brunswick (3) and Nova Scotia (1).

The foregoing table shows that for Canada as a whole more than 73 per cent of all the foreign-born males resident in the Dominion were of voting age, June, 1911. In British Columbia and Ontario the proportion of males of alien birth 21 years and over was above the average for Canada—being 85.67 per cent for the former and 77.96 per cent for the latter. In both these provinces the excess of males of voting age is accounted for by the presence of a large Oriental and Italian element which is almost wholly made up of male labourers of mature years. As regards the former, the heavy transportation rates and immigration requirements render it unprofitable to bring women and children, and, in the case of the Italians, they being largely employed on railway construction work, the continual moving from place to place militates against the establishment of homes and the consequent presence of women and children. In the other provinces of the Dominion, Prince Edward Island excepted, the proportion of males, foreign-born, who had reached the age of 21 years was fairly level.

being 71.59 per cent in Manitoba, 69.93 per cent in Quebec, 68.12 per cent in Alberta, 67.52 per cent in Saskatchewan, 66.64 per cent in Nova Scotia, 62.67 per cent in New Brunswick and only 34.04 per cent in Prince Edward Island.

Table 12 gives the number and per cent of the qualified voting population at date of June, 1911, which were born in Canada, elsewhere in the Empire, or in foreign countries.

For all Canada the naturalized foreign-born constituted only 6.62 per cent of the total voting male population. In Ontario it was 2.90 per cent, in Quebec 2.66 per cent, in New Brunswick 1.35 per cent, in Nova Scotia 1.13 per cent of the male population 21 years and over. In the Western provinces the percentage was much higher, being 24.92 per cent in Alberta, 23.01 per cent in Saskatchewan, 17.20 per cent in Manitoba and 9.48 per cent in British Columbia. In Quebec and the Maritime provinces more than 90 per cent of the males who by age and citizenship were entitled to the franchise were native born. In Ontario the proportion was nearly 75 per cent, it was 40.24 per cent in Alberta, 45.18 per cent in Manitoba and 46.17 per cent in Saskatchewan. The British born (including under the heading persons born in the British Islands and British possessions other than Canada) constituted nearly 52 per cent of the males 21 years and over in British Columbia, 34.84 per cent in Alberta and 30.82 per cent in Saskatchewan.

Table 13 gives the number of foreign-born males of voting age resident in Canada June, 1911, classified according to citizenship and country of birth by provinces. It also combines the totals for the four western provinces and for the Maritime provinces and shows that 94,324 or 71.85 per cent of the foreign-born naturalized were in the Western provinces, 21,022 or 16.01 per cent in Ontario, 13,042 or 9.93 per cent in Quebec and 2,874 or 2.19 per cent in the Maritime provinces.

Table 14 gives by percentages the information contained numerically in Table 13. For Canada, as a whole, in every 1,000 males of voting age born in Denmark 647 were naturalized, in Germany 582, in France 501, in the United States 414, in Austria-Hungary 413, in Belgium 406, in Russia 402, in Norway and Sweden 395, in Turkey and Syria 372, in Holland 304, in Bulgaria and Roumania 304, in Greece 178 and in Italy 174 per 1,000 males 21 years of age and over resident in Canada in 1911 were naturalized.

The country of origin of the naturalized male population of voting age is ranked for each province in the following statement according to the proportion of the male immigrants 21 years and over from the specified countries who were citizens of the Dominion in 1911.

Only in the provinces of Quebec and Nova Scotia have males of voting age born in the United States constituted the highest proportion of the naturalized. Natives of Germany ranked second for Canada as a whole, and for British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Quebec and New Brunswick and first in Ontario. Males of voting age whose country of origin was Denmark ranked first for Canada, British Columbia, Saskatchewan, Manitoba and New Brunswick and second in Ontario. Natives of France, according to percentages of males 21 years and over naturalized ranked first in Alberta, second in Manitoba, third in Ontario, fourth in Quebec, Saskatchewan and British Columbia and sixth in Nova Scotia. Table 13 shows that, according to total numbers of males of voting age naturalized for Canada, as a whole, the United States contributed the greatest number, followed by Austria-Hungary, Russia, Germany, Norway and Sweden in the order named. In the four western provinces the order was United States, Austria-Hungary, Russia, Norway and Sweden and Germany. Of the 2,449 foreign-born males 21 years and over in the Yukon, all were aliens except eleven—one born in Norway and Sweden and ten in the United States.

The racial origin of the immigrants born in the United States is indicated by the figures of table 15. The fact that for more than 14 per cent of the total number born in the United States the racial origin was not reported, or if reported, was set down as "American"—a term which, in the sense used, does not designate any ethnological division of the white races, limits to some extent an analysis of the various races represented in the immigrant population from that country resident in Canada. These immigrants are given under 24 specified origins, but under some of these headings, the country of origin rather than the racial origin is given; for example, included under Austria-Hungarians are Austrians, Hungarians, Poles, Ruthenians, Teutons, etc. Persons of British racial origins constituted 52.36 per cent of the total foreign-born who claimed the United States as their country of origin, and of these 48 per cent were reported as being of English origin, 27½ per cent of Scottish and 22½ per cent of Irish; those of German, French and Scandinavian origins ranked next in the order

named. More than 92.50 per cent of immigrants of known origins born in the United States and resident in Canada were of British, German, French or Scandinavian races.

While of the total immigrants of British racial origins born in the United States and classed as being of alien birth in the census returns, 51.58 per cent were naturalized, yet the immigrants of other races showed a naturalization of nearly 56 per cent as compared with 52.29 per cent for the total immigrant population born in the United States. The highest proportion of naturalization is shown for immigrants who claimed to be of French origin, being 73.5 per cent of all classes and 61 per cent of males of voting age, followed by those of Scottish origin, with 55.5 per cent for the former and 45 per cent for the latter. The lowest percentages of naturalization were recorded for the American born immigrants of Bulgarian (34.1 per cent), Italian (30.3 per cent), Russian (28.3 per cent) and Greek (19 per cent) origins.

The foreign-born Jews in Canada June, 1911, are classified according to country of birth and citizenship in Table 16. Of the total population (75,681) of Jewish origin 47,861 or 63·2 per cent were born outside of the British Empire. The table shows that of the foreign-born Jews, 43,216 or more than 90 per cent were born in three countries—Russia (33,930), Austria-Hungary (3,952) and Roumania (5,334). From Asia there were only 180. A little less than one-half of all the foreign-born Jews in Canada could claim Canadian citizenship, and of all the males 21 years of age and over 9,167 or 52·7 per cent out of a total of 17,395 were naturalized.

Tables 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21 deal with the foreign-born population in cities of 15,000 population and over. Table 17 gives the number of the foreign-born in the cities specified according to years of arrival in Canada. Sixteen cities of this class have each a foreign-born population of 2,000 or over. The following statement shows for these cities the per cent proportion which the foreign-born constitutes of their total population.

From the foregoing it will be seen that although numerically the numbers of the foreign-born in Montreal and in Toronto are greater than in any of the western cities, yet their percent proportion to the total population is much smaller, being 9.2 per cent for Montreal and 8.8 per cent for Toronto, as compared with 28.7 per cent for Vancouver, 24.2 per cent for Winnipeg, 22.6 per cent for Regina, 22.5 per cent for Edmonton and better than 20 per cent for Victoria and Calgary.

Among the following cities with fewer than 15,000 inhabitants, the foreign-born were 15 per cent or better of the total population in 1911, being 28 per cent in Port Arthur, 24 per cent in New Westminster and North Vancouver, 23 per cent in Lethbridge and Sault Ste. Marie, 20 per cent in St. Boniface, 17 per cent in Nanaimo and 15 per cent in Saskatoon.

The great disparity in the ratio of males to females of alien birth in the cities of Victoria and Vancouver is due in a great measure to the presence of a large oriental element. In Victoria there were 3,223 males to 152 females, or in the proportion of 21 to 1, while in Vancouver males were 5,439 to females 522, or better than 10 to 1. The foreigners who made Brantford, Fort William or Sydney their headquarters in 1911 were mostly males from southern and south-eastern Europe and were employed in factories, on railway construction or in connection with the mining industry. In the city of Westmount only did the foreign-born females exceed the males.

The table also shows that 87 per cent of the foreign born in Fort William had come to Canada since 1900, in Sydney 86 per cent, in Regina 80 per cent, in Calgary 79 per cent, in Brantford and Edmonton 76 per cent, in Toronto and Vancouver 71 per cent, in Hamilton 70 per cent, in Montreal 68 per cent, in Victoria 66 per cent, in Ottawa 54 per cent, in Windsor 49 per cent and in Berlin 38 per cent of the total foreign population in 1911 were immigrants of the years subsequent to 1900.

In Table 18 the foreign-born males of voting age in the cities specified are classified according to citizenship and years of immigration by quinquennial periods. As previously stated, the large numbers for whom the year of arrival in Canada was not reported limits to some extent the value of the statistics presented. Fourteen cities in Canada at the last census possessed each more than 1,000 foreign-born males of voting age. The number and percentage of the naturalized in those cities being as follows:—

For all cities in this category, excepting Montreal, Ottawa and Berlin, more than one-half of the foreign-born males 21 years and over had come to Canada in the years immediately preceding the Fifth Census. In Berlin, with 63.5 per cent naturalized, the majority of the men of alien birth had been in the Dominion more than twenty years previous to June, 1911.

The number and percentage of the voting population classified as British-born and naturalized are given in Table 19 for all cities having 15,000 or more inhabitants.

It will be observed that only a relatively small percentage of the voting population were born in alien countries. -In Winnipeg it was 11.1 per cent, in Edmonton 11.2 per cent, in Berlin 14.5 per cent, in Calgary and Regina 7.5 per cent, in Montreal and Vancouver 5.8 per cent and 5.5 per cent respectively. In all other cities of this class the proportion of the total vote, which was foreign-born, ranged from 1.3 per cent in Windsor, Ont., to 4.5 per cent in Fort William. Although Toronto, with 3,766 naturalized men stood third in the list numerically, yet the ratio of the naturalized voters to voters by birthright was only 32 to 968.

In Table 20 the numbers of the foreign-born males 21 years of age and over naturalized and alien, are given according to country of birth for cities of 15,000 and over, and Table 21 gives the same information by percentages. It will be interesting to note the variation in the percentages of naturalization of the foreign-born according to location. For example, 46.72 per cent of the foreign-born Germans in Montreal are naturalized, as compared with 29.95 per cent in Toronto, 31.07 per cent in Vancouver, 71.63 per cent in Ottawa, 73.71 per cent in Hamilton, 66.67 per cent in Fort William and 76.85 per cent in Berlin.
