# Commodity Innovation Series NEW PRODUCTS CONTAINING PROPOLIS

#### FEBRUARY 2017



Globally there were 228 products containing propolis introduced between January 2010 to October 2016, with 193 launched in Food, 20 in pet food and 15 in drinks.

During the evaluation period, the use of propolis has been on a rise, with the most new product launches (43) occurring in 2016. Globally, Brazil saw the most new product launches containing propolis, with a total of 44. While Mexico was the second largest, followed by Japan and France.

Broncolin, Famille Michaud Apiculteurs, and Han Herred Bolcher are the top companies in the world to launch the most products containing propolis. Broncolin launched 13 products, followed by Famille Michaud Apiculteurs with 6 products, and Han Herred Bolcher with 5 all which were launched within the sugar and gum confectionery and sweet spread product categories.

#### INTRODUCTION

According to Mintel Global New Product Database (GNPD), from January 2010 to October 2016, there were 228 product launches in the world. Of the total products lauched 66.7% of them were new, while 33.3% were re-launches due to new packaging, new variety and range extension.




Figure 1: New Products Containing Propolis, from Januarry 2010 to October 2016

In figure 1, you can see there is a growing use of propolis in product launches around the world and 2016 is expected to see the highest growth within the review period.

#### **REGIONS**

Within the review period forty countries in the world launched products containting propolis. The Europe region launched the most products with a total 83, followed by Latin America (76), and Asia Pacific (54). However, countries within the Latin America region launched the most products such as Brazil with a total of 44 products and Mexico with 24 (see *figure 2*).

The product categories to have the most product launches containing propolis, were sugar and gum confectionery, sweet spreads, and pet food. All together accounted for 91% of new launches (see figure 3). Within the sugar and gum confectionery category, medicated confectionery accounted for 75% of product launches in the category, followed by boiled sweets with 16 launches. In the sweet spreads, honey was the largest sub-category with 40 launches. Lastly, in the pet food category, cat food wet and dog food dry were the main sub-categories to have product launches containing propolis (see figure 4).

#### **COMPANY AND BRAND**

In the review period, 185 companies across the world launched products containing propolis. The company to launch the most products was Broncolin with a total of 13 launches mostly occurring within the last three years of the review period. Most of Broncolin's product launches occurred in Mexico and the US within the sugar and gum confectionery category.

The second largest company to launch propolis products was Famille Michaud Apiculteurs with a total of 6 products, all of which were launched in 2015 and 2016. Most of Famille Michaud Apiculteurs products are sweet spreads. The company launched it products in various countries around the world such as France, Singapore, Crotia, and Malaysia.

The third largest country was Han Herred Bolcher with a total of 5 products, most of which was launched in European countries such as Denmark, Finland, Germany, Norway, and Sweden. The company launched most of its products within the sugar and gum confectionery category.




Figure 5: Top 10 Companies and Their Top Brands, from Januarry 2010 to October 2016


Figure 6: Top Countries and their Top 3 Companies to Launch New Products Containing Propolis, from Januarry 2010 to October 2016

#### **PRODUCT CLAIMS**

The top claims of product launches containing propolis were health and wellness related with functional benefits, low/no/reduced allergen and gulten-free being the leading claims across the world. In Asia Pacific, functional claims was most common, while in Europe, the Middle East and Africa, low reduced sugar was the leading claims.

#### CONCLUSION

In conclusion, within the past few years propolis is increasly being used as an ingredient in new health and wellness product launches, primarly in medicnal sugar and gum confectionery products. However, there is growing use in other product categories such as pet foods and in beverages.

Propolis usage is highly common in Latin American countries such as Brazil, Mexico, and Agrentina. In addition to European and Asia Pacific countries such as France, Spain, Italy, Japan, and South Korea.
