AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$501 MILLION IN 2016

ARIZONA EXPORTED \$402 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$262M in vegetables
- \$76M in fruits and nuts
- \$35M in food preparations*
- \$12M in non-alcoholic beverages
- \$5M in dairy products



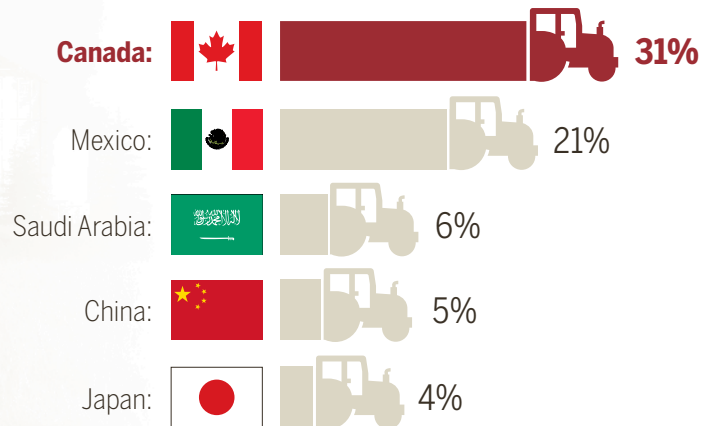
ARIZONA IMPORTED \$99 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$12M in animal feed
- \$11M in baked goods
- \$9M in chocolate products
- \$8M in vegetables
- \$6M in fresh/frozen beef

* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
