

- → \$5M in dairy products








ARIZONA IMPORTED \$99 MILLION FROM CANADA. INCLUDING:

- → \$12M in animal feed
- → \$11M in baked goods
- → \$9M in chocolate products
- → \$8M in vegetables
- → \$6M in fresh/frozen beef

*The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
