AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$3.1 BILLION IN 2016

ILLINOIS EXPORTED \$1.4 BILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$179M in food preparations*
- \$168M in baked goods
- \$94M in fats and oils
- \$93M in chocolate products
- \$80M in prepared cereal grains



ILLINOIS IMPORTED \$1.7 BILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$309M in baked goods
- \$174M in fats and oils (incl. \$118M in refined canola oil)
- \$157M in fresh/frozen meat (incl. \$81M in pork)
- \$135M in candy and gum
- \$128M in chocolate products

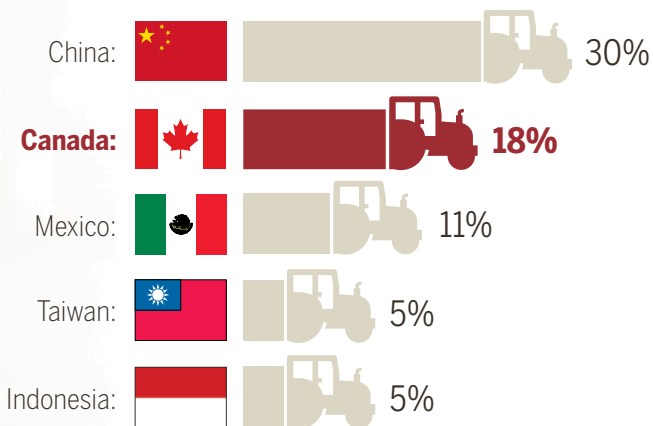
