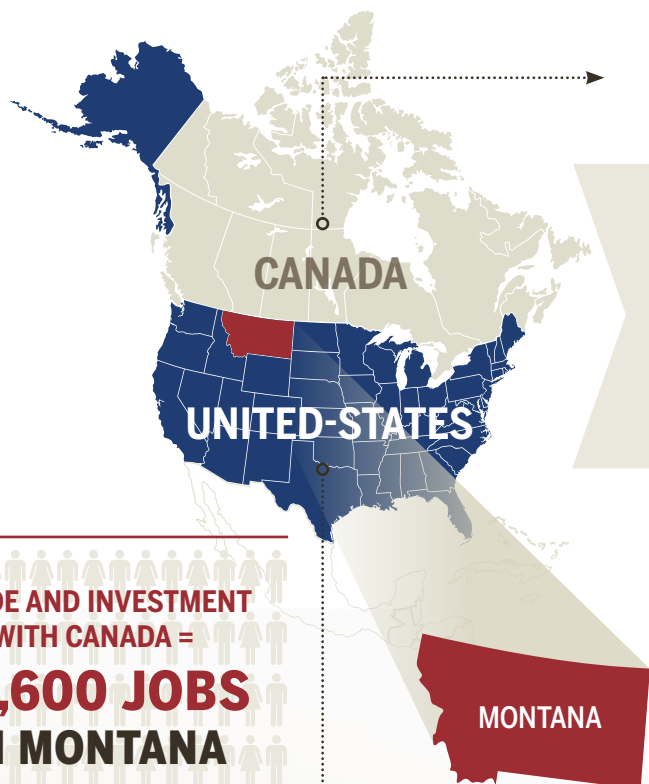

AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$369 MILLION IN 2016

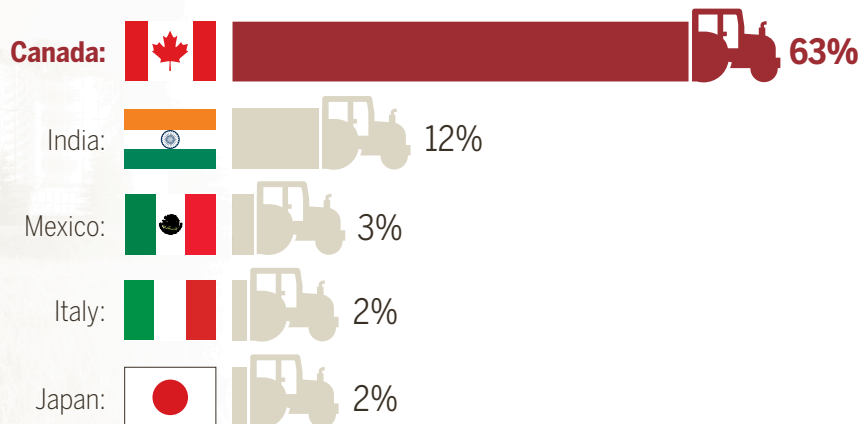
MONTANA EXPORTED \$275 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$28M in vegetables (incl. \$19M in dried lentils)
- \$13M in malt
- \$13M in live animals
- \$13M in wheat
- \$3M in canola seeds

MONTANA IMPORTED \$94 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$28M in animal feed (incl. \$21M in canola meal)
- \$17M in barley
- \$14M in wheat
- \$12M in oil seeds
- \$7M in live animals
