- \$28M in baked goods
- \$26M in vegetables
- \$25M in tobacco

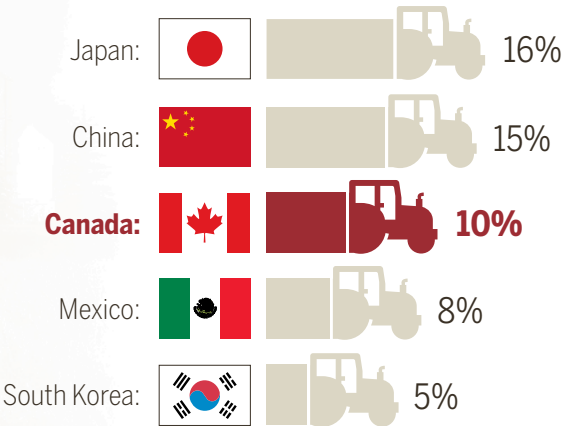


**NORTH CAROLINA IMPORTED \$326 MILLION
