AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$47 MILLION IN 2016

RHODE ISLAND EXPORTED \$6 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$3M in sausages
- \$652K in food preparations*
- \$610K in coffee extracts
- \$557K in purebred breeding horses
- \$248K in baked goods

RHODE ISLAND IMPORTED \$41 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$15M in fresh/frozen pork
- \$7M in dog and cat food
- \$4M in vegetables
- \$3M in baked goods
- \$1M in maple sugar and syrup

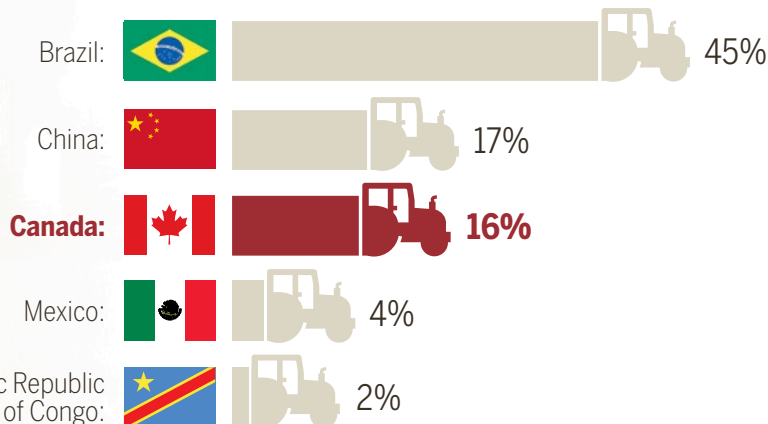
