




## TENNESSEE IMPORTED \$391 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

\*The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
