AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$617 MILLION IN 2016

TENNESSEE EXPORTED \$226 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$61M in baked goods
- \$25M in prepared cereal grains
- \$21M in animal feed (incl. \$19M in dog and cat food)
- \$15M in malt extract, mixes and doughs
- \$15M in chocolate products

TENNESSEE IMPORTED \$391 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$87M in fats and oils (incl. \$54M in canola oil)
- \$79M in food preparations*
- \$53M in malt extract
- \$25M in sugars and candy
- \$13M in coffee

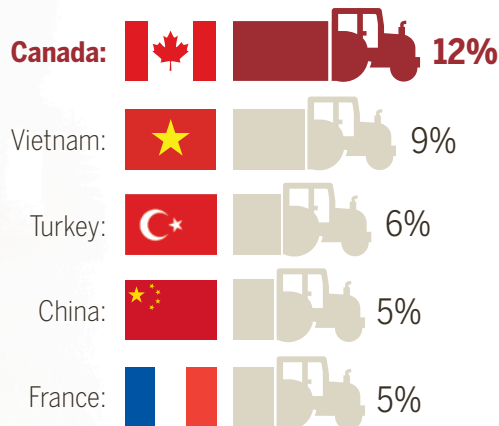
* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
