**AGRICULTURAL TRADE =
\$2 BILLION IN 2016**

**WISCONSIN EXPORTED \$1.3 BILLION
TO CANADA, INCLUDING:**

- \$157M in ethanol
- \$142M in fur skins
- \$99M in food preparations*
- \$139M in prepared meat
- \$71M in malt extract, mixes and doughs

**WISCONSIN IMPORTED \$664 MILLION
FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:**

- \$83M in fresh/frozen meat (incl. \$63M in beef)
- \$67M in live animals
- \$55M in oats
- \$52M in animal feed
- \$38M in cow semen

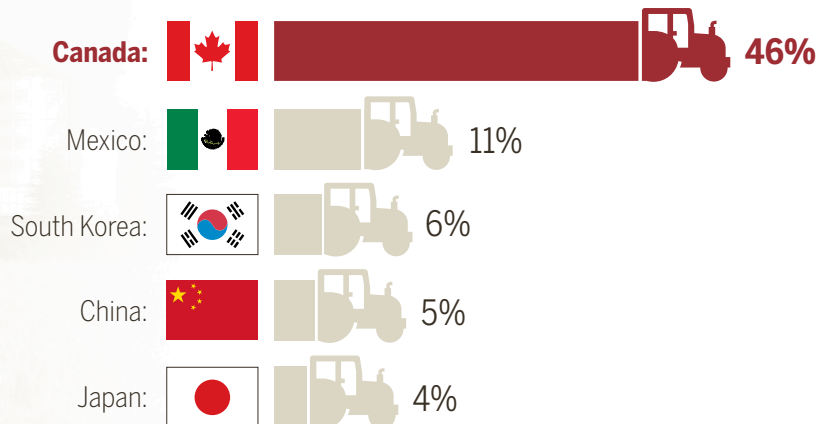
