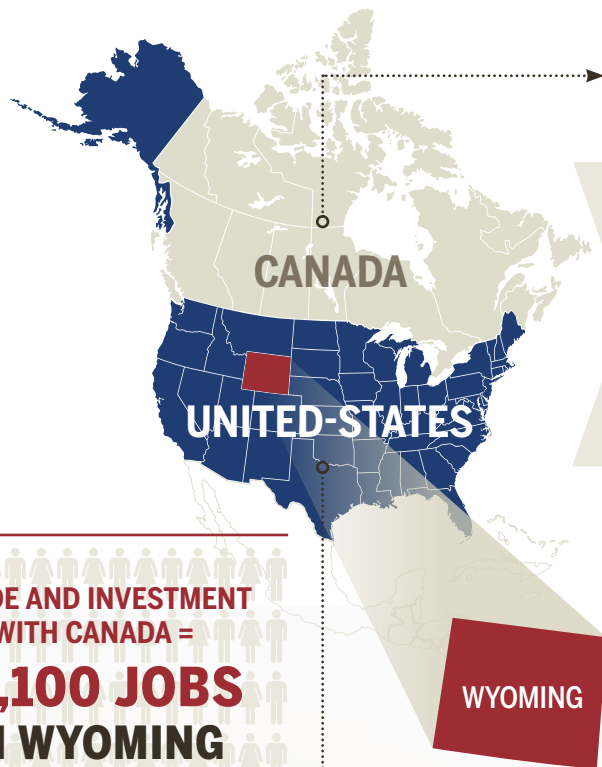


WYOMING-CANADA

AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$14 MILLION IN 2016

WYOMING EXPORTED \$5 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$1M in sugar beet seeds
- \$1M in dried beans and peas
- \$1M in vegetable extracts
- \$611K in sauces and condiments
- \$250K in live animals (incl. \$98K in cattle)

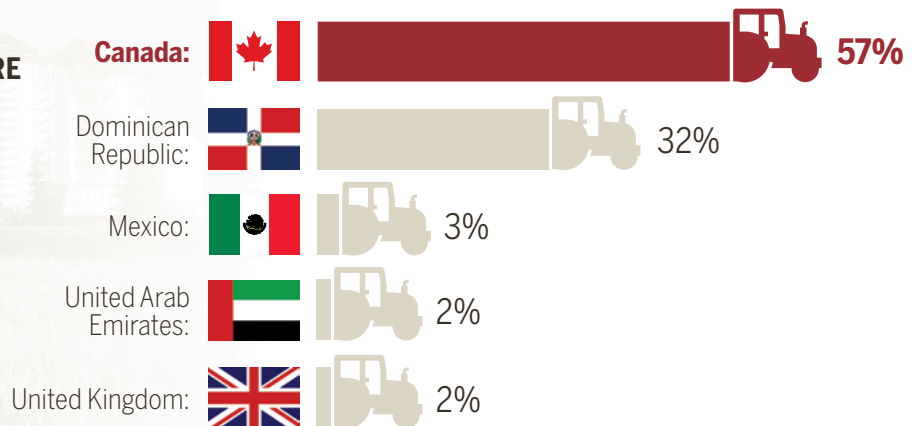
WYOMING IMPORTED \$9 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$4M in baked goods
- \$3M in live animals (incl. \$2M in cattle)
- \$1M in oats
- \$403K in fresh cherries
- \$287K in live trees and plants
