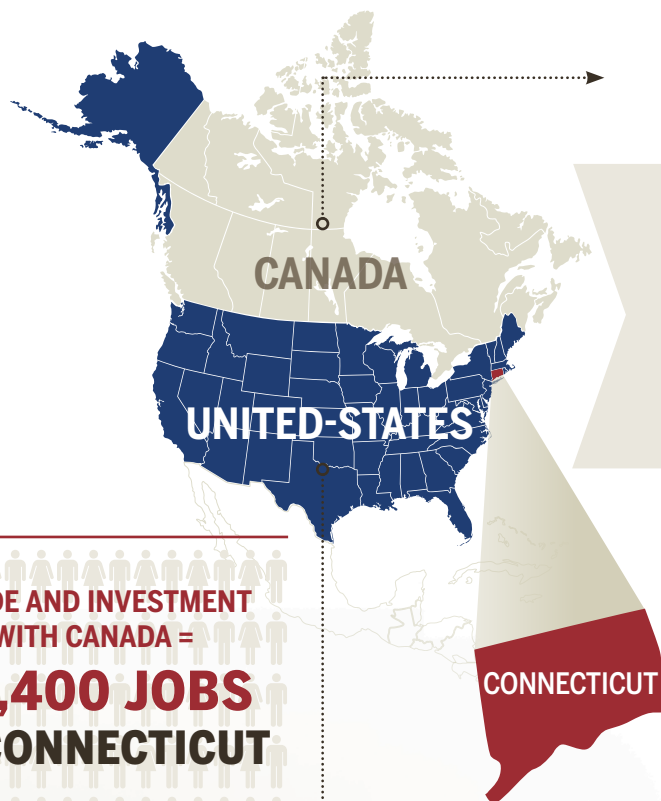

\$262 MILLION IN 2016**

**CONNECTICUT EXPORTED \$70 MILLION

- \$4M in tomatoes
- \$4M in ketchup and tomato sauces

**CONNECTICUT IMPORTED \$192 MILLION
FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:**

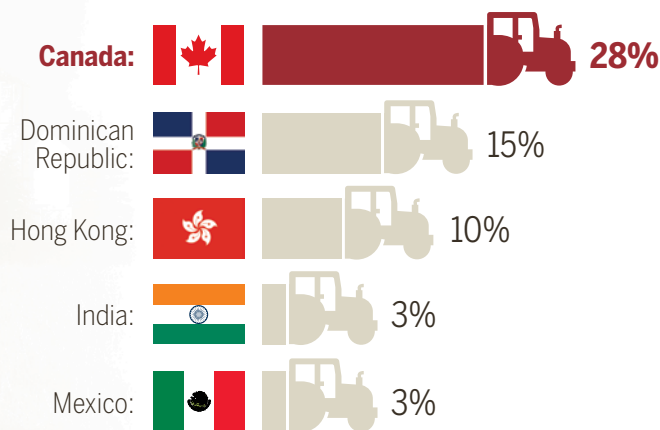
- \$30M in frozen fries
- \$18M in ethanol
- \$16M in coffee
- \$14M in baked goods
- \$14M in fresh/chilled beef

* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
