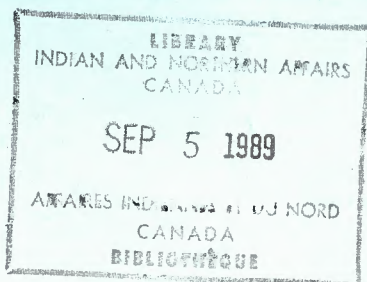

Family Unit Definition

For the purposes of this survey a family unit shall mean a natural family consisting of a family head and one or more other persons related to the head by birth, marriage or adoption. The following exceptions should be noted.

- (1) Any unmarried person, 21 years of age or older, whether living alone or with someone else, will be considered a family unit.
- (2) Any female, 16 years of age or older, who has one or more children residing with her, whether she and her children are living in a separate residence or with someone else, will be considered a separate unit. In the event that the children are considered part of their grandparents family, she will not be treated as a family unit.
- (3) A parent or parents residing with a son or daughter will be considered a separate unit.

- (ii) Angirrag - Two adults
- Mother and daughter any age
- Father and son any age
- Father and Mother with child under 12

- (iii) 2 bedroom houses - Married couple plus one other adult
- Two childless married couples
- Two married couples when either or both have a child under 12
- Parents with 2 children providing that
 (a) both of one sex
 (b) children of different sexes if one is under 12

- (iv) 3 bedroom houses - Larger families not filling (i), (ii) and (iii) above.
