

**Advice to Researchers: Haltbreeds Primary Source Material**

Sometimes conditions will arise that make it difficult or impossible to secure the material listed in Haltbreeds-Primary Source Material. The foreward will outline some methods for dealing with these conditions.

Researchers should become acquainted with the Public Archives of Canada's methods before attempting to secure material. The clerks at the circulation desk are often too busy to deal with requests for information. If the researcher has any questions, there is a research consultant in the reference room ready to deal with any research problems. The Public Archives also publishes an excellent guide called Manuscript Division - The Researcher's Guide. This guide is available free from the Manuscript Division, Public Archives of Canada, 395 Wellington Street, Ottawa, Ontario, K1A ON3.

Because of the aged, delicate condition of some of the holdings, the Public Archives must occasionally withdraw material from circulation for restoration or microfilming. If material is unavailable under these conditions, the researcher often must wait from a week to a month. In this case, the researcher should leave a telephone number with the archivist in order that the researcher may be advised when the material is again available.

Materials will occasionally be microfilmed without the appropriate notation appearing in the main entry card on the finding aid. The researcher should ask to see the microfilm listings.

Because of the large volume of material handled by the Public Archives, documents may occasionally be misplaced or even misfiled. To facilitate locating "lost" references, check the finding aid for the unit or series involved, find the notation and show it to the clerk. This may serve to "jog" his/her memory as to the material's location. Any material which is misfiled should be brought to the attention of the Archives staff.

The amount of material stored by the Public Archives is constantly growing, necessitating the removal of some holdings to satellite buildings. There is usually a half-day wait for materials ordered from satellite storage (documents ordered after 3:00 p.m. cannot be delivered until the next working day). There is no way to speed this process as only Public Archives staff are able to secure such material

If the researcher has done all of the above and is still unable to secure the material needed, it is still possible to take the search one step further. The best resource people at the Public Archives on matters of Indian and Métis documentation are David Hume and Robert Armstrong (both at (613) 996-8507).

Finally, situations may arise where, even though the material is obtainable, the researcher will not be allowed to view it for reasons of confidentiality. This can be for one of several reasons: (i) the materials were donated to the Public Archives by a private organization, company or person

which does not wish the material open to the general public (e.g., the Hudson's Bay Company Papers, which require permission from the Company before they may be viewed); (ii) the materials fall into the "exempted" category (e.g., classified information, information that might lead to a breach of faith or confidence with another Government, or might violate the right of privacy of any individual). Throughout a major part of the history of the Indian Department, agents on Indian reserves were required to carry out a multiplicity of tasks: social worker, medical officer, farm instructor, lawyer, etc. Thus, a document which contains factual information might also contain information of an extremely personal nature. Note on Sources

i) Sources Reviewed

- (a) RG10 Series (Black and Red) Records Relating to Indian Affairs (1872-1950) Public Archives of Canada.

These records, including original Indian Treaties, consist of letterbooks, minute books, general orders, memoranda, reports, petitions, land records, etc. relate to all aspects of the work of the Indian Affairs department and its predecessors in the Province of Canada, Upper Canada, Lower Canada and Quebec, together with inherited documents such as the records for the Commission for Indian Affairs at Albany (1721-1748). Both Headquarters and Agency records are well represented. The listings for this group contained herein are only the file numbers. To acquire these documents, the researcher must use the RG10 Conversion List (held in the PAC Reading Room) to convert the file number into a volume number.

- (b) Sir John A. Macdonald Papers (MG26A) PAC

There are many references to Indian and Métis matters in the Prime Ministers' papers, particularly those of Sir John A. Macdonald who also held the position of Superintendent-General of Indian Affairs (1878-1887). The Sir John A. Macdonald papers are available on microfilm.

ii) Other Sources that should be examined

(a) Record Group 15: Department of the Interior Records - some useful material relating to Indian matters is to be found in this Record Group, particularly on that of halfbreeds of the Mackenzie Valley District and Manitoba.

(b) Record Group 18: North-West and Royal Canadian Mounted Police Records - These records contain much material relating to Indian matters.

(c) Manuscript Group 20: Hudson's Bay Company Records - A microfilm copy of these records is held at the Public Archives but is only available to researchers with the Company's permission. The originals are now held in the Provincial Archives in Winnipeg under the jurisdiction of Shirlee Smith, archivist.

(d) Record Group 85: Northern Administration Branch Records - these records contain material concerning the Indians of the Yukon and the NWT.

(e) Deputy Superintendent-General Letterbooks, 1879-1924 (volumes 1078-1133) 37 reels 33 mm. - the private letterbooks of the Deputy Superintendent-General.

(f) Headquarters Letterbooks, 1871-1920 (Volumes 4376-5836) 619 reels 35 mm. - a set of indexed letterbooks containing copies of departmental correspondence relating to the administration of Indian Affairs in both Eastern and Western Canada.
