It is extremely difficult to make any prediction of enrolment for this school. The school enrolment has been dropping during the last few years. This is partially due to the fact that Agency Superintendents are regularly reminded that no child will be admitted to the school until all possibilities of foster home placements have been exhausted. There is also the fact that in one agency at least the Children's Aid Society has been active with a result that few applications are received from that agency. There is a possibility that other Children's Aid Societies may soon have their effect on the enrolment of the Shubenacadie Indian Residential School.

It is recommended that the present procedure with regard to this school be continued with the hope that the enrolment continue to drop. The enrolment within the next few years may drop to from fifty to seventy-five. Should this happen then it will be recommended that the possibility of boarding the children in cities to attend public schools be explored. Alternately space could be made available in the Shubenacadie Indian Residential School for residential school children from other regions if such space is required.

At present other than teaching staff the Maritime Region is served by one District Superintendent of Schools, One Supervising Principal (Eskasoni) and One Teacher Counsellor.

The number of pupils chiefly in need of guidance services at present includes 134 High School students, 21 Vocational Training Students and 17 University and Teacher College students. This is not to mention grades seven and eight pupils in Indian Schools for whom additional guidance services are required.
