The Literacy and Essential Skills Toolkit offers support in three key areas:

ASSESSMENT

Use these tools to better understand the Literacy and Essential Skills strengths and weaknesses of an

organization, or of an individual.

LEARNING

TRAINING SUPPORTS

Use these tools to improve Literacy and Essential Skills levels.

Use these tools to support the delivery of Literacy and Essential Skills training.

Examples of assessment tools:

- a needs assessment that identifies skill strengths and weaknesses within an organization
- a hiring checklist to determine if a candidate demonstrates the Literacy and Essential Skills required for a position
- a series of computer-scoreable assessment questions that provide an indication of skill levels
- paper-based assessment questions for different Essential Skills

Examples of learning tools:

- tip sheets and practice exercises to improve Literacy and Essential Skills
- passports and portfolios to track an individual's skill development
- techniques and practice exercises to improve problem solving skills

Examples of training supports:

- a 7-step guide on how to develop Literacy and Essential Skills training for the workplace
- a list of ideas on how to incorporate Literacy and Essential Skills training activities into the workplace
