



AN ARTIST'S MONUMENTAL VOYAGE.

Emily Carr (1871-1945) was born in Victoria (British Columbia) and spent numerous years exploring the Pacific Northwest. Her travels of 1912 are considered the landmark voyage that inspired her to begin preserving British Columbia's First Nations communities through her art. It was a life-long endeavour that produced an extraordinary body of work on the changing ways of life among these cultures, and created a new mythos of the Pacific wilderness through haunting portrayals of the landscape.

Today, Emily Carr is considered one of Canada's most important contemporary artists.

Carr discovered towering totem poles as she explored British Columbia's coast. She was the first West Coast artist to approach First Nations people, and their communities, culture and artifacts as a serious subject of artistic study.

WOLF SONG.

BEAR OF AWE AND RESPECT.

This gold coin is the perfect acquisition for those who've always wanted to own a gold coin or would like to express their passion for wildlife in a unique way.

Its miniature yet incredibly detailed design features a grizzly's profile with its distinctive concave silhouette that sets it apart from the black bear's straighter lines.

The name "grizzly" comes from the grizzled or light-coloured fur on the bear's head and shoulders. Its long fur tends to make it look heavier than it actually is. Still, the grizzly is second in size only to the polar bear and can move very quickly—up to 48 km/h!

This powerful, solitary predator eats mostly berries, nuts, leaves and roots, but during the annual salmon run, as many as a dozen individuals will gather at prime fishing spots to feast on fish to build up their fat for the winter.

REMARKABLE REIGN.

In our history, only two Sovereigns have ever celebrated a Diamond Jubilee. The first was Queen Victoria who celebrated 60 years on the throne in 1897. The second is Queen Flizabeth II who marked her Diamond Jubilee in 2012

Such a remarkable reign is further reflected in the number of effigies that appear on circulation coins. To date, Elizabeth II has been celebrated with four different portraits, and this must-have series brings each one into the spotlight.

The Queen's first effigy appeared in 1953 and was unique for the way it depicted the young queen without a crown. It's a cherished image that has been perfectly re-created on this remarkable pure gold coin. Another standout feature: two unique maple leaves—a tribute to the special relationship Elizabeth II shares with Canada as its head of state.

LEGEND OF THE BIG DIPPER.

The Big Dipper is arguably one of the most recognized star formations in the night sky and has inspired many First Nations legends. One of them describes how tracks of a giant bear were discovered circling a village. When the animals began disappearing from the forest, the elders asked that the bear be stopped before it brought starvation to the people. In response, three hunters set out to track the bear. They chased it across the Earth, right up into the sky!

The Quest is the first of four coins that tells the full story of the Bigger Dipper. It shows the hunters as they begin pursuing the great bear. In the background, the Big Dipper glows in the dark; a foreboding sign of the eternal hunt that is to come.

LAND OF THE BEAVER.

Canada's three natural realms of land, sky and sea mingle in a landscape of unmatched grandeur. Similarly, its people—First Nations and modern inhabitants alike—overlap within this landscape in a unique experience of shared history and nationhood. The Royal Canadian Mint proudly presents a new series that celebrates this interconnectedness through the stunning artwork of West Coast artist Andy Everson.

The first release adopts a beaver as its central motif while ingeniously incorporating Canada's four seasons. This central motif is framed within a wreath of six maple leaves representing autumn. Arranged in a six-point pattern, the leaves also become a winter snowflake. Nestled between the leaves are six stylized raindrops, celebrating spring. Finally, rays of sunlight emanate from the image, symbolizing summer. Like the seasons themselves, each element of the design blends into the next.





VIKING QUEST.

How far would you travel to feed your family? Would you climb aboard a ship and set sail with no shore in sight, hoping to find new land and resources?

This is what hundreds of men did when Scandinavia (now Norway, Denmark and Sweden) could no longer support its growing population. As Viking colonies expanded to Greenland, Iceland and northern Europe, ocean voyages across the North Atlantic became a regular occurrence—and then Bjarni Herjolfsson's ship was blown off course and he spotted land.

Was it Newfoundland or Labrador? For centuries, the *Grænlendinga Saga* and its mythical Vinland kept historians guessing—until 1960 when a 1,000-year-old Viking settlement was discovered in Newfoundland.

Then, in 1977, a Viking shipwreck was discovered on Skræling Island off the Ellesmere coast, and in 2002, archaeologists discovered what may be a second Viking outpost on Baffin Island. Canada's history keeps unfolding—celebrate it with this adventure-packed coin.

RING OF NATURAL TREASURES.

This intriguing coin celebrates the boreal forest, an important global ecosystem that occupies more than 300 million hectares in Canada—from the Yukon Territory to Newfoundland and Labrador, and extends about 1,000 km south from the Arctic tundra. It's home to many of Canada's iconic plant and animal species, and plays a critical role in climate regulation by holding more than 200 billion tonnes of carbon in its soil, trees, mosses and water—part of the largest carbon store on Earth.

The boreal forest is visible from space as a dark green ring around the northern hemisphere; a perspective that's echoed in this coin's design. It entices the viewer to rotate the coin to discover the many species hidden within: sugar maple, bur oak, jack pine, beaver, black bear, bald eagle, ruby-throated hummingbird, red squirrel, white spruce, white-tailed deer, Canada goose, eastern white pine, blue heron—and many more.

SHOWY AS ITALIAN THEATRE.

The Harlequin duck is brightly coloured, just like Harlequin, the mad character in the traditional Italian commedia dell'arte. Males are slate blue with white, black and russet markings while females are a subdued brown for protection against predators.

This pretty little duck is about 30-50 cm long and weighs less than a kilogram. It's a strong swimmer with a distinctive mouse-like call that has earned it the nickname "sea mouse."

Despite its bright colours, the Harlequin duck is difficult to spot. It lives on the isolated, rocky shores of the Pacific and Atlantic coasts during the winter, and moves inland to breed in fast-moving freshwater streams in summer.

Whether you choose the coloured coin or monochrome silver, these endearing keepsakes will win a special place in your collection.
