NATIONAL FLAG OF CANADA (ONE-EVENT-ONLY USE)

1. SCOPE

- 1.1 This standard applies to the design, colours and performance of the National Flag of Canada intended for one-event-only use.
- 1.2 The testing and evaluation of a product against this standard may require the use of materials and/or equipment that could be hazardous. This document does not purport to address all the safety aspects associated with its use. Anyone using this standard has the responsibility to consult the appropriate authorities and to establish appropriate health and safety practices in conjunction with any existing applicable regulatory requirements prior to its use.

2. APPLICABLE PUBLICATIONS

- 2.1 The following publications are applicable to this standard:
- 2.1.1 Canadian General Standards Board (CGSB)

- 2.2 Reference to the above publications is to the latest issues unless otherwise specified by the authority applying this standard. The sources for these publications are shown in the Notes section.

3. TERMINOLOGY

- 3.1 For the purposes of this standard, the following definition will apply:
- 3.1.1 *One-event-only use flag* A flag which is manufactured for use during a period of time of up to but not exceeding twenty-four hours.

4. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

4.1 The flag shall be free from imperfections and blemishes that may affect its appearance.

5. DETAILED REQUIREMENTS

5.1 **Design** — The flag shall be of the proportions two by length and one by width, containing in its centre a white square the depth of the flag, with a single red maple leaf centred therein, in accordance with Figure 1.

5.2 **Colours** — The red and white colours shall have the following CIE (International Commission on Illumination) colour co-ordinates when measured in accordance with ASTM E 308 using Illuminant D_{65} and the 1964 Standard Observer:

Red	14.6	0.535	0.312
White	88.9	0.312	0.320

5.3 **Colourfastness to Water** — The flag shall not show change in colour or staining greater than Grey Scale 4 when tested in accordance with CAN/CGSB-4.2 No. 20-M.

6. PREPARATION FOR DELIVERY

6.1 Unless otherwise specified (par. 8.1), preparation for delivery shall conform to normal commercial practice.

7. INSPECTION

7.1 **Sampling** — Sampling for inspection and testing shall be at the discretion of the inspection authority unless a specific sampling plan is specified (par. 8.1).

8. NOTES

- 8.1 **Options** The following options must be specified in the application of this standard:
 - a. Packaging and packing details, if other than as specified (par. 6.1)
 - b. Sampling, if a specific plan is required (par. 7.1).


