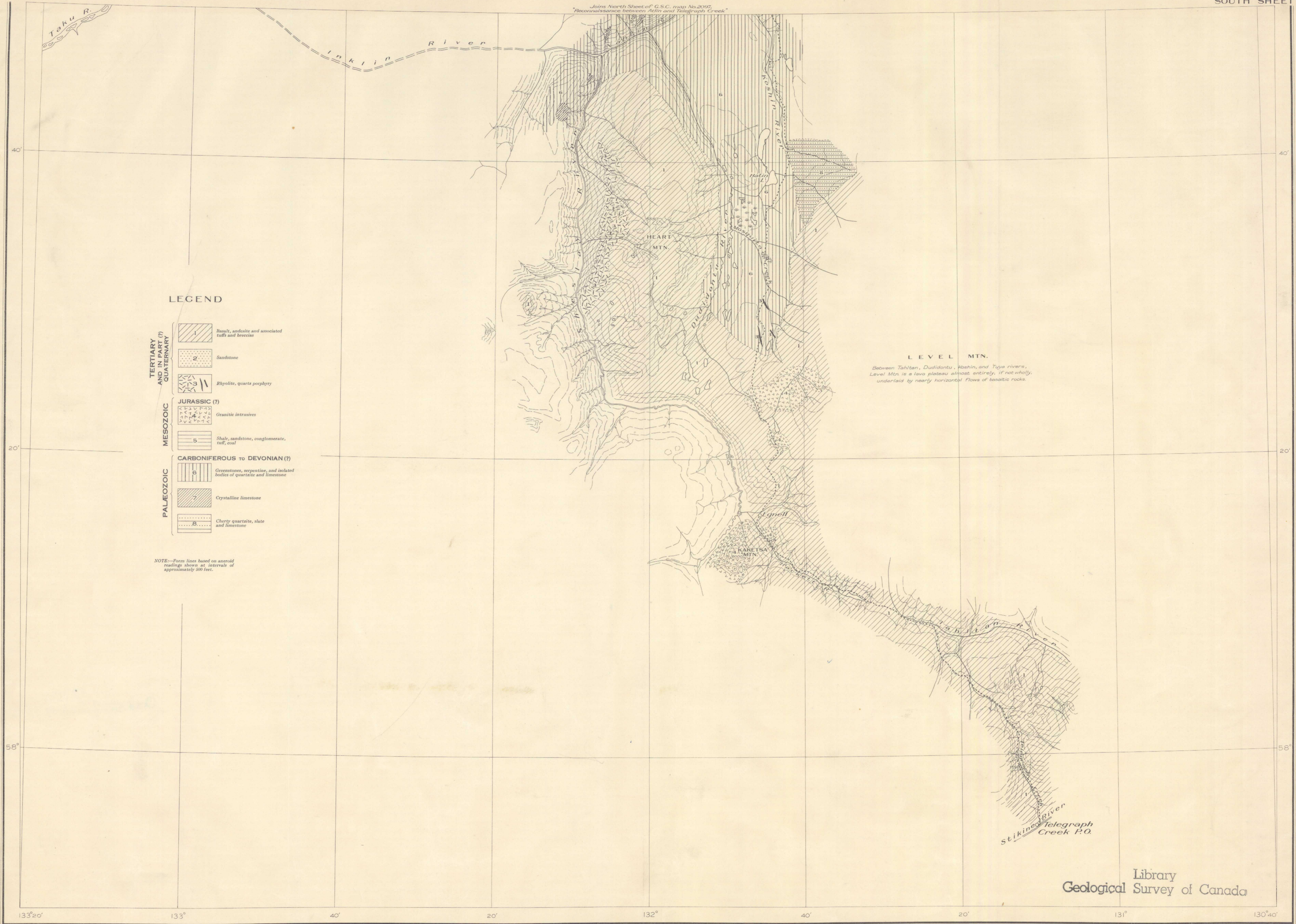

LEGEND

 - Shale, sandstone, conglomerate, tuff, coal

LEVEL MTN.
 Between Tahltan, Duddontu, Koshin, and Tuva rivers, Level Mt. is a lava plateau almost entirely, if not wholly, underlain by nearly horizontal flows of basaltic rocks.
