INTRODUCTION

The United Nations Centre for Human Settlements estimates that across the world...

- one billion people do not have adequate shelter
- 100 million have no shelter whatsoever
- every day, inadequate shelter, dangerous water supply and poor sanitation contribute to the deaths of 50,000 people, mainly children
- by the Year 2000, half the population of the developing world will live in urban areas, most of these will live in slum and squatter settlements.

And in Canada, an inquiry carried out by the Canadian Council for Social Development concluded that...

- over 10,600 people spent the night of January 22, 1987 in a temporary shelter; and
- shelters housed over 100,000 individuals in 1986.

In recognition of the lingering and enormous global shelter crisis, the United Nations declared 1987, the International Year of Shelter for the Homeless, IYSH. It was an opportunity to renew commitment to establishing shelter as a basic right and to support initiatives undertaken by the poor and homeless themselves.

As a result of the Year, the United Nations adopted a new Global Shelter Strategy that gives emphasis to the role that non-government and community organizations play in housing and shelter. The Strategy calls upon governments to support these initiatives by adopting "enabling strategies".

Many concerned Canadians began to work more closely together during 1987 and following a major IYSH Conference in Ottawa, an Agenda for Housing Action was prepared. Efforts are underway to form local, regional and national coalitions to press for solutions Canada's persistent housing problems and to promote increased Canadian support to Third World shelter programs. (A listing of some of the new resources produced during IYSH, including the Agenda for Action is provided in Appendix 2.)

Rooftops Canada Foundation is a non-profit organization whose members live and work in housing cooperative organizations across Canada. Rooftops Canada's main objectives are to better inform Canadians about housing issues in developing countries, and to raise funds and to provide technical assistance to community based shelter projects overseas. With assistance from the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) and the Canadian International Development Agency, Rooftops Canada carried out a number of IYSH activities:

- support to IYSH demonstration projects in Africa, Asia, Latin America and the Caribbean
- publicizing IYSH through the distribution of a bulletin, Shelter News
- producing a guide to Canadian resources for Third World shelter
- working with other organizations to establish the Canadian Agenda for Action.

This Catalogue of Canadian Housing and Shelter Organizations is another aspect of Rooftops Canada's IYSH program. It lists 384 organizations that provide shelter and housing services across Canada. As a contribution to the International Year of Shelter for the Homeless, the Catalogue has three objectives. First, it is intended improve access to housing and shelter facilities and services by locating and providing basic information about them. Second, the Catalogue should assist people and organizations to contact one another and to work together more effectively. Third, it may assist those undertaking research into housing and shelter issues in Canada.

#### How the Catalogue was Compiled

Both leading up to and during IYSH there were many discussions about which group of Canadians were of concern. Some argued that only those people who are actually homeless should be considered. Others suggested a wider definition to include people with severe affordability or accessibility problems and finally it was argued that everyone with a "housing" problem should be considered.

This Catalogue is deliberately open-ended in its definition of the housing and shelter problem and so includes organizations whose members or target groups are those people who do not have access to the private ownership market.

Broadly speaking, this is the Canadian "social housing" or not-for-profit housing sector. In addition, it includes many organizations that provide services used by the homeless such as food, clothing, information and referral. From the beginning the Catalogue was also intended to only list non-government organizations and only those that explicitly agreed to be listed.

It was also decided not to discriminate as to the area served by the organization. These range from neighbourhood information centres to national housing organizations. It was however decided to not list individual housing cooperatives even though all of these have some proportion of their units dedicated to rent-geared-to-income households and many serve special housing needs. This is because there are now over 1400 housing co-ops across Canada. They can be contacted through the resource groups and federations which are listed in the Catalogue.

A Registration Form (reproduced in Appendix 1) was first mailed in February 1987 to 1637 organizations on the mailing lists of the Canadian Council for Social Development (CCSD), the Canadian Association of Housing and Renewal Officials (non-government members only), the Urban Core Support Network and the UN Habitat Information Office for North America. The CCSD list was the largest and widest ranging, it was compiled for the national inquiry into homelessness, another IYSH activity funded by CMHC.

A second follow-up mailing was sent out in May 1987 with an additional third mailing in French to all organizations listed in Quebec. The last was undertaken because the response rate to the earlier mailings to Quebec in English was low. This was done even though funding for the project did not anticipate either translation or any telephone or other follow-up.

To encourage responses, the Registration Form was deliberately designed to be filled out in a very short period of time and a return envelope was provided. As additional encouragement, copies of Shelter News, a special IYSH news bulletin, were sent with the form. Further issues were offered to those who returned the form whether they wanted to be listed in the Catalogue or not. This proved to be a very useful indicator.

Of the 476 responses received, 92 indicated that although they wanted to receive **Shelter News**, they did not wish to be listed in the catalogue. No reasons were requested, but based on experience working with emergency shelters, some reasons for this can be suggested. All too often providers of shelter services are already so overloaded that they do not wish to further advertise their presence, and many shelters for assaulted women and families do not list their location to protect the personal security of their users.

The Catalogue lists 384 of the one thousand organizations that the CCSD estimates provide housing, shelter and/or related services. Of those listed, a very small number are government agencies. Although, it was not intended to list any government agencies, registration forms were received by some and it was decided to include those that had taken the trouble to respond.

#### Organization of the Catalogue

The Catalogue is organized by province from east to west across Canada. Due to the large number of responses, the listings for Ontario are further broken down into regions. Within each province or region, listings are alphabetical by city or town. And again, listings within each city or town are alphabetical. In a few cases, names starting with "The" are listed as such following information provided by the organization, e.g. entry 131, "The Salvation Army Family Services Dept."

The following example will help explain the entries:

The number "234" is the index number for the entry and it is used in the Catalogue Index which lists organizations by the groups to which services are directed. In this case the Kitchener-Waterloo YWCA is listed under "Female Only" as number 234. The address and phone number are as provided by the organization in 1987.

With regard to the Services, those shown in combined upper and lower case letters are ones that were checked off on the Registration Form. If the organization provided additional information it is shown all in upper case letters, in this example "EMERGENCY SHELTER FOR WOMEN, BUILDING AFFORDABLE APTS. FOR 1989".

Similarly for Target Group, additional information is all upper case. The Kitchener-Waterloo YWCA indicates that "THOSE NOT SERVED CURRENTLY WILL BE SERVED IN NEW FACILITY".

The Service Area indicates the area in which the service is provided or it may also be thought of as the area from which users of the service are drawn. In this case, the YWCA serves the cities and region of Kitchener-Waterloo.

It should also be pointed out that all co-op housing resource groups and federations are listed even though only about half of these provided detailed information as in the above example. The rest are simply listed as either a resource group or federation.

The catalogue information is also stored electronically in a database program, "PC-File+", from which data can also be transported into other database programs. This would make it feasible to expand and update the Catalogue.

### Profiles of the Organizations

Although not part of the project design some broad profiles of the information provided by the 384 organizations listed in the Catalogue have been prepared. Table 1 shows the geographic distribution of the listed organizations.

Table 2 indicates the number of organizations providing different services. On average, each organization listed 3.5 services or activities. This suggests both that the problem of housing and shelter is a multi-faceted one, and that in response community organizations have become integrated multi-service providers. For example of the 245 organizations supplying housing and/or shelter, 198 also have counselling and referral services and 172 carry out information and advocacy work.

The third table indicated the groups to which the 384 organization's services are directed. It suggests that many organizations work with broad constituencies. Table 4 provides some indication of the extent to which services are restricted to one group or another. For example, over one third of the organizations work exclusively with girls or women. The groups providing restricted services can be found using the Index which follows the listings.

### SHELTER FOR THE HOMELESS RESOURCES

The following is a list of some of the documents and educational resources prepared for the International Year of Shelter for the Homeless. These materials will continue to be of interest to organizations concerned with housing and shelter issues both in Canada and in the developing world.

#### 1. Homelessness in Canada: The Report of the National Inquiry

In January 1987, the Canadian Council for Social Development canvassed hundreds of individuals and organizations in a "snapshot" survey of agencies providing services to people in temporary and emergency shelters. The Council also held consultation workshops across Canada to address the causes of homelessness and to develop new approaches.

#### 2. Canadian Agenda for Action on Housing and Homelessness

The Canadian Association of Housing and Renewal Officials (CAHRO) undertook to prepare an agenda for Canadian housing action following from the conclusions of the Ottawa IYSH Conference. The Agenda considers the causes of the housing problem in Canada and in developing countries, principles for action and immediate steps to be taken. It is hoped that many Canadian organizations will adopt the Agenda as the basis for working together in coalitions around Canadian housing concerns and Canada's role in assisting Third World shelter initiatives.

#### 3. New Partnerships - Building for the Future

The Proceedings of the Canadian Conference to Observe the International Year of Shelter for the Homeless report on the deliberations of over 1400 participants from across Canada and many developing countries. #### 4. Case Studies of Shelter Related Initiatives Relevant to Developing Countries

Documents 100 projects involving Canadians in the provision of shelter and basic infrastructure. Seventy-five cases are in developing countries and 25 are domestic examples relevant to Third World projects. The main criteria for selecting projects were replicability, innovation, increased self-help capacity and benefits to the poor and homeless. The projects from 38 countries, range from planning and design to community development, and research. Nearly 60% of the projects surveyed are NGO based. An introduction to settlements in developing countries is also provided. The report was prepared by Chreod International for the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada. ### 5. Shelter and the Homeless: Teaching Materials Kit

Prepared by Unicef Ontario, this kit is recommended for use with grades 4 to 8. Teachers will find background information, lists of contacts and audio-visual resources which provide a basic introduction to shelter and homelessness in Canada and in the developing world. Activity cards and classroom ideas suggest flexible curriculum units that can focus on homeless children. Kits are \$3.00 from Unicef Ontario, 333 Eglinton Avenue East, Toronto, Ontario M4P 1C7.

### 6. Guide to Canadian Resources for Third World Shelter

The Guide lists non-government organizations, academic institutions and professional firms that provide resources for shelter in developing countries. Assistance may be financial, technical or material support, research or training. Specializations, countries in which they have worked, typical projects, resources and publications are listed. The Guide is intended to provide Third World partners with better access to Canadian resources and to help Canadians work together more effectively. ### 7. Shelter for the Homeless Audio/Visual Guide

Rooftops Canada has prepared an audio-visual guide for groups concerned with shelter issues. Materials were selected to reflect appropriate technologies, attention to community participation, a critical approach to development issues, sensitivity to local cultures, the role of women and appeal to viewers of various ages. Low price and availability across Canada in English or French were also considered. Audio/visual catalogues are also listed for those requiring additional in-depth material. ### 8. Building for Change: Slide/Tape or Video

A new IYSH audio/visual produced by Asterisk Films for Rooftops Canada, Shelter for the Homeless...Building for Change provides an introduction to Third World shelter and development problems along with practical solutions through community organization. The show explores squatter and slum settlements through two grassroots projects: one in the Mathare Valley in Nairobi and the other in Santiago. Just 12 minutes long, the show fits easily into an evening workshop or class. Available in either slide/tape or VHS video format from Rooftops Canada.
