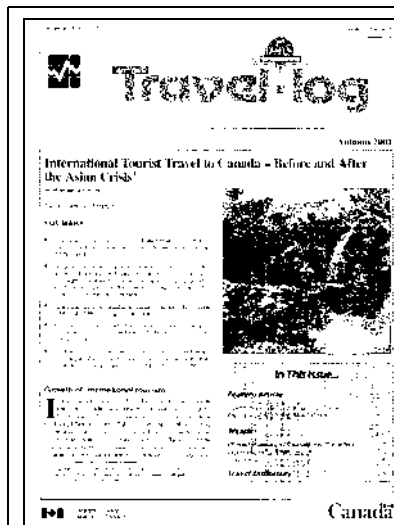

Travel-log Autumn 2001

The Autumn 2001 issue of *Travel-log*, Statistics Canada's quarterly tourism newsletter, features the article, "International tourist travel to Canada—before and after the Asian Crisis." Where does international tourism in Canada stand following the 1997 Asian Crisis? This article examines the situation two years after the fact. Data from the International Travel Survey show, among other things, a recovery of travel from Asian and other overseas countries in Canada from 1998 to 1999. However, travellers made slightly fewer such trips than they did in 1997.

Each quarter, *Travel-log* examines the trends of the Travel Price Index. It also features the latest travel indicators, travellers' characteristics and the international travel account.

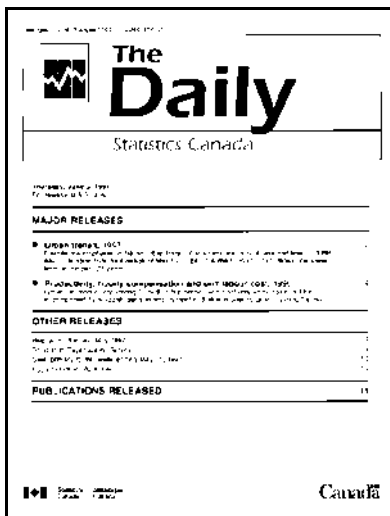
