February 2001

Manufacturers shipped 513 557 metric tonnes of cement in February, down 13.5% from 593 730 tonnes (revised) in January 2001, and down 9.4% from 566 556 tonnes (revised) in February 2000.

Year-to-date shipments totalled 1 107 287 tonnes, up 6.9% from 1 035 679 tonnes (revised) during the same period in 2000.
