February 2001

Sawmills produced 5 857.6 thousand cubic metres of lumber and ties in February, a 0.7% decrease from 5 903.0 thousand cubic metres in February 2000.

Year-to-date production was 11 641.0 thousand cubic metres, down 0.2% from 11 673.9 thousand cubic metres in the same period of 2000.
