Domestic sales of refined petroleum products

March 2001 (preliminary)

Sales of refined petroleum products totalled 7 811 800 cubic metres in March, up 4.9% from March 2000. Sales increased for six of the seven major product groups, with the largest gains recorded for heavy fuel oil (+174 900 cubic metres or +33.1%), light fuel oils (+98 800 cubic metres, +19.7%), motor gasoline (+57 400 cubic metres, +1.9%) and diesel fuel (+54 900 cubic metres, +2.9%). The advance in heavy fuel oil sales reflects higher usage of the product by utilities for electricity generation.

Sales of premium motor gasoline and regular non-leaded motor gasoline increased by 4.0% and 1.9%, respectively, compared with March 2000. Sales of mid-grade motor gasoline dropped 4.0% over the same period.

Year-to-date sales of refined petroleum products were up 1 060 600 cubic metres or 4.7% higher than in the same period in 2000. Sales increased for all seven major product groups, the largest advances were for heavy fuel oil (+530 600 cubic metres or +32.6%), light fuel oil (+230 400 cubic metres or +11.9%), and motor gasoline (+124 000 cubic metres or 1.4%).

Steel primary forms

Week ending April 28, 2001 (preliminary)

Steel primary forms production for the week ending April 28 totalled 266 355 metric tonnes, down 11.4% from 300 557 tonnes a week earlier and down 6.0% from 283 300 tonnes in the same week of 2000. The year-to-date total at the end of the reference week was 4 728 892 tonnes, down 12.7% from 5 418 266 tonnes produced in the same period of 2000.


