#### Canadian social trends

Autumn 2001

Each quarter, Canadian social trends integrates data from many sources to examine emerging social trends and issues. The Autumn 2001 issue includes the following articles: "Family disruptions and childhood happiness," "Kids and teens on the Net," "Generosity: 30 years of giving," and "Mobile homes in Canada."

The first examines how family disruptions during childhood, such as divorce or a parent's death, can influence adults in later life. Other articles examine the extent to which children aged 5 to 18 have access to the Internet at home; analyse changes in household spending on gifts and charitable donations; and profile people who live in mobile homes. Canadian social trends also features the latest social indicators, as well as information about Statistics Canada's products and services.

# Industrial chemicals and synthetic resins July 2001

Chemical firms produced 247 822 metric tonnes of polyethylene synthetic resins in July, a 9.3% rise from 226 650 tonnes in July 2000.

Year-to-date production to the end of July totalled 1 752 683 tonnes (revised), up 11.9% from 1 565 766 tonnes in the same period of 2000.

Data are also available on production of 3 other types of synthetic resins and 24 industrial chemicals.


