Help-wanted Index

February 2002

The Help-wanted Index (1996=100) stood at 124 in February, nearly unchanged (-0.8%) for the second straight month. This follows eight consecutive months of declines.

Ontario, Quebec and Nova Scotia saw no change; an increase in Newfoundland and Labrador was offset by small declines in the other provinces.

Compared with February 2001, the national index was down 26.6%.

Note: The help-wanted Index is compiled from the number of help-wanted ads published in 22 newspapers in 20 major metropolitan areas, and is considered an indicator of labour demand, measuring companies' intentions to hire new workers. These indices have been seasonally adjusted and smoothed to ease month-to-month comparisons.

Steel primary forms

Week ending March 2, 2002 (preliminary)

Steel primary forms production for the week ending March 2 totalled 319 935 metric tonnes, up 1.0% from 316 796 tonnes a week earlier and up 8.1% from 295 969 tonnes in the same week of 2001. The year-to-date total at the end of the reference week was 2 706 240 tonnes, up 12.6% from 2 403 059 in the same period of 2001.


