April 2002

Chemical firms produced 280 512 metric tonnes of polyethylene synthetic resins in April, up 4.1% from 269 507 tonnes in April 2001.

Year-to-date production at the end of April totalled 1 159 289 tonnes, up 14.4% from 1 013 308 tonnes (revised) in the same period of 2001.

Data are also available on production of three other types of synthetic resins and 24 industrial chemicals.

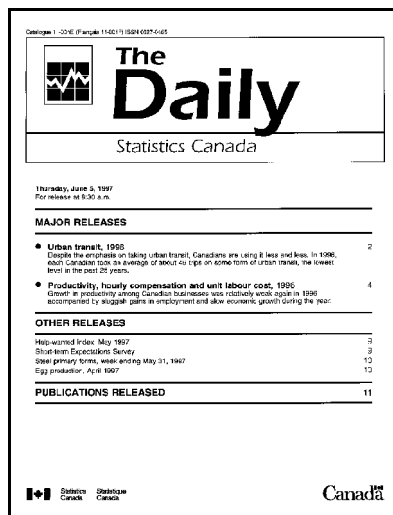
