Statistics: Power from data!

This reference tool also touches on the importance of confidentiality, privacy and security, and the various uses and misuses of information in today's society. Links to related lesson plans allow teachers to select the most grade-appropriate exercises available and to supplement their curriculum.

Cereals and oilseeds review

November 2002

During December, Chicago nearby soybean and corn futures' prices lost between 5 and 10 cents a bushel. Archer Daniels Midland reduced its US soybean crush rates because of poor crush margins and continued to shift some of its crushing operations to China. However, forecasts for another record soybean crop in South America were the principal negative factor with an impact on the market. Strong soybean exports to China limited the price decline. Corn futures' prices were pressured by continued low exports, news that a shipment to Japan was tainted by StarLink and poor prospects of increased domestic feed demand offsetting slack offshore demand.

Soybean prices weighed on Winnipeg canola futures. March canola futures' prices lost more than \$20 a tonne over the month, as limited non-Japanese demand, increased farm deliveries, and large commercial stocks also pushed prices down. The absence of fresh commercial demand lowered flaxseed futures by about \$20 a tonne.

Data from the November 2002 issue of *Cereals* and oilseeds review are now available. The information includes data on production, stocks, cash and futures prices, domestic processing, exports, farmers' deliveries and supply-disposition analyses. The annual summary of processing is included in the November publication.

The December situation report, an overview of current market conditions, both domestic and international, is also included in November's issue of *Cereals and oilseeds review* (22-007-XIB, \$11/\$112; 22-007-XPB, \$15/\$149), which will be available in February. See *How to order products*.

Aircraft movement statistics: Major airports

October 2002

There were 519,357 take-offs and landings recorded in October at the 99 airports with Nav Canada air traffic control towers or flight service stations, down 2% from the 98 airports reported in October 2001.


