Aircraft movement statistics: Small airports

December 2002

There were 36,605 take-offs and landings recorded in December at the 107 airports without air traffic control towers, down 22.3% from December 2001, when 112 airports reported 47,119 take-offs and landings.

Note: The TP141 monthly report is issued in two volumes. Volume 1 presents statistics for the major Canadian airports (those with NAV CANADA
