Subscribe to *The Daily* by subject

You can now subscribe online to releases from *The Daily*, Statistics Canada's official release bulletin, on the basis of one or more of 27 subjects.

Until recently, you could only subscribe to the entire *Daily* and get a copy in plain text format every working day. With the new approach, you can subscribe to your choice of designated subjects, and receive links to releases or product release announcements by e-mail, only when they contain information related to your chosen subjects.

This new system offers a more flexible service and ensures you are kept up to date on information on these specific topics.

You can choose from the following subjects: agriculture; arts, culture and recreation; business enterprises; communications; construction; education; energy; environment; geography; government; health; justice; labour; manufacturing; national accounts; personal finance and household finance; population and demography; prices and price indexes; primary industries; reference; science and technology; service industries; social conditions; statistical methods; trade; transport and warehousing; and travel and tourism.

To subscribe by subject, click on the *Free subscription* button from *The Daily's* page on Statistics Canada's website (www.statcan.ca). Choose the subjects to which you wish to subscribe by clicking on the corresponding checkboxes.

You will receive, by e-mail, links to all the new data releases and product release announcements associated with your chosen subjects when they are released in *The Daily*.

- **Urban transit, 1995** 2
Despite the problems on taking urban transit, Canadians are using it less and less. In 1996, about 10 million Canadians took an average of about 40 trips on some form of urban transit, the lowest level in the past 25 years.
- **Productivity, hourly compensation and unit labour cost, 1995** 4
Growth in productivity among Canadian businesses was noticeably weak again in 1996, accompanied by sluggish gains in employment and slow economic growth during the year.
