The Consumer Price Index and you: A new learning resource

A new learning resource is available today online to help students understand how the Consumer Price Index (CPI) reflects price changes for the goods and services they buy.

The Custom Inflation Simulator demonstrates how the many consumer goods and services in the "basket" are used to calculate the CPI, and how consumption patterns differ from person to person. Using the simulator, students can also see the effect of individual price increases on overall inflation and how each item in the basket is "weighted" to reflect its importance in the consumption patterns of Canadians.

Steel primary forms, weekly data

Week ending September 25, 2004 (preliminary)

Steel primary forms production for the week ending September 25 totalled 302 308 metric tonnes, up 0.6% from 300 471 tonnes a week earlier and 4.2% higher compared with 290 122 tonnes in the same week of 2003.

The year-to-date total as of September 25 was 11 842 413 tonnes, up 3.0% from 11 502 161 tonnes in the same period of 2003.


