### **Steel primary forms, weekly data** Week ending July 31, 2004 (preliminary)

Steel primary forms production for the week ending July 31 totalled 328 387 metric tonnes, up 14.4% from 287 095 tonnes a week earlier and 9.0% from 301 276 tonnes in the same week of 2003.

The year-to-date total as of July 31 was 9 455 764 tonnes, up 2.7% from 9 209 315 tonnes in the same period of 2003.

### **Postal Code Conversion File Plus** December 2003

The *Postal Code Conversion File Plus* (PCCF+), Version 4D (82F0086XDB, free) with postal codes up to December 2003, complements the *Postal Code Conversion File* (PCCF). While the association between the postal code and census geography is not unique, the PCCF+ allows for a proportional allocation based on the population count.

Despite the emphasis on taking urban transit, Canadians are using it less and less. In 1996, each Canadian took an average of about 40 trips on some form of urban transit, the lowest level in the past 25 years.

Growth in productivity among Canadian businesses was relatively weak despite the fact accompanied by sluggish gains in employment and slow economic growth during the year.
