Farm product prices

June 2004

Prices received by farmers in June for grains, oilseeds, specialty crops, fruits, vegetables, cattle, hogs, poultry, eggs and dairy products are now available.

The Manitoba slaughter cattle price in June was \$63.35 per hundredweight, down 21% from May 2004, but up 35% from June 2003 when it reached \$46.85.

The June "non-board" wheat price in Saskatchewan was \$149.55 per metric tonne, up 5% from May's

price and up 14% from the June 2003 price when it reached \$130.74.

Despite the emphasis on taking urban transit, Canadians are using it less and less. In 1996, each Canadian took an average of about 40 trips on some form of urban transit, the lowest level in the past 25 years.
- **Productivity, hourly compensation and unit labour cost, 1995** 4
Growth in productivity among Canadian businesses was noticeably weak again in 1996 accompanied by sluggish gains in employment and slow economic growth during the year.
