Production and disposition of tobacco products

November 2004

Total cigarettes sold in November by Canadian manufacturers decreased 19.5% from October to 2.7 billion cigarettes, and was 20.6% lower than the level observed in November 2003.

Cigarette production for November increased 12.2% from October to 3.8 billion cigarettes, but was down 1.9% from November 2003.

At 4.5 billion cigarettes, the level of closing inventories for November increased by 24.2% from October, and was 21.8% higher than the level recorded in November 2003.

Steel primary forms, weekly data

Week ending December 25, 2004 (preliminary)

Steel primary forms production for the week ending December 25 totalled 271 469 metric tonnes, down 6.0% from 288 734 tonnes a week earlier and up 2.3% from 265 403 tonnes in the same week of 2003.

The year-to-date total as of December 25 was 15 843 725 tonnes, up 2.6% from 15 435 823 tonnes in the same period of 2003.
