# Production and disposition of tobacco products

January 2005

Canadian manufacturers sold 2.6 billion cigarettes in January, down 20.9% from December but 0.5% higher compared with January 2004.

Cigarette production was up 26.5% from a month earlier to 3.0 billion in January and 1.2% higher compared with January 2004.

At 3.7 billion cigarettes, the level of closing inventories for January advanced 12.2% from December, and was 9.0% higher compared with January 2004.

#### Steel primary forms, weekly data

Week ending February 26, 2005 (preliminary)

Steel primary forms production for the week ending February 26 totalled 321 683 metric tonnes, down 2.5% from 329 785 tonnes a week earlier and down 1.7% from 327 289 tonnes in the same week of 2004.

The year-to-date total as of February 26 was 2 535 567 tonnes, down 0.8% from 2 557 049 tonnes in the same period of 2004.
