Data from Cycle 2 of the Youth in Transition Survey (YITS) conducted in 2002 are now available for special tabulations. Changes in expenditure on taking urban transit; Canadians are riding it less and less. In 1996, each Canadian took an average of about 40 trips on some form of urban transit, the lowest level in the past 25 years.

Growth in productivity among Canadian businesses was relatively weak again in 1996, accompanied by sluggish gains in employment and slow economic growth during the year.
