# Domestic sales of refined petroleum products

March 2005 (preliminary)

Sales of refined petroleum products totalled 8 861 800 cubic metres in March, up 2.3% from March 2004. Sales increased in three of the seven major product groups, led by diesel fuel oil (+7.0% or up 145 900 cubic metres) and motor gasoline (+2.8% or 93 000 cubic metres), while sales of aviation turbo fuels posted the largest decline (-4.7% or down 27 500 cubic metres).

Sales of regular non-leaded (+3.1%) and sales of premium (+3.2%) rose while mid-grade (-10.9%) fell from March 2004.

Year-to-date sales of refined petroleum products at the end of March reached 25 769 500 cubic metres, up 2.7% from the same period of 2004. Sales rose in five of the seven major product groups, with the largest increase in diesel fuel oil (+6.8% or up 401 800 cubic metres).

## **Annual Survey of Consumer Goods Rental** 2003

The consumer goods and general rental industry earned operating revenues of almost \$2.3 billion in 2003, up 2.8% from 2002. The operating profit margin for the industry was 7.1% in 2003 compared with 6.9% in 2002.

Both national and provincial results from the 2003 Annual Survey of Consumer Goods Rental (and revised 2002 data) are now available and include data on revenue, expenses, salaries, wages and benefits, and operating profit margin.


