Payroll employment, earnings and hours May 2008 (preliminary)

The average weekly earnings of employees stood at \$791.48 in May, up 0.3% from April. Compared with a year earlier, average weekly earnings rose 3.1% whereas consumer prices increased 2.2%.

In May, earnings among Canada's largest industrial sectors increased by 6.2% in accommodation and food services, 3.0% in health and social assistance, 2.8% in retail trade, 2.6% in manufacturing, and 2.2% in educational services, compared with May 2007.

The strongest year-over-year earnings growth was reported in Alberta (+5.4%), Saskatchewan (+5.0%) and Newfoundland and Labrador (+4.9%).

Although down marginally from April to May (-4,800), the number of employees in Canada was up 252,200 (+1.8%) in May compared with the same period last year.

Production and disposition of tobacco products

June 2008

Manufacturers produced 1.7 billion cigarettes in June, down 10.8% from the previous month. The total number of cigarettes sold increased by 1.0% to 1.6 billion and closing inventories rose 3.0% to 2.4 billion cigarettes in June.

Note: This survey collects data on the production of tobacco products in Canada by Canadian manufacturers and the disposition or sales of this production. It does not collect data on imported tobacco products. Therefore, sales information in this release is not a proxy for domestic consumption of tobacco products.

Placements of hatchery chicks onto farms totalled 59.2 million birds in June, down 1.7% from June 2007. Placements of turkey poults on farms increased 4.0% to 2.3 million birds.
