Crude oil and natural gas: Supply and disposition

July 2009 (preliminary)

Domestic production of crude oil and equivalent hydrocarbons totalled 13.3 million cubic metres in July, down 4.1% from July 2008.

Crude oil and equivalent exports were up 15.0% compared with the same month in 2008. About 75% of Canada's total domestic production went to the export market.

Marketable natural gas production totalled 11.7 billion cubic metres in July, down 8.7% from the same month a year earlier. Domestic sales of natural gas rose by 0.9% from the same month a year earlier.

Natural gas exports fell by 2.8% in July compared with the same month in 2008. Exports accounted for about 68% of marketable natural gas production.

Commercialization of intellectual property in the higher education sector

2007

Canadian universities and affiliated teaching hospitals reported more than \$52 million as income from intellectual property in 2007, down 12% from 2006.

In 2007, researchers reported or disclosed 1,357 new inventions to Canadian universities and teaching hospitals, a number virtually unchanged from the previous year. There were 1,634 patent applications filed with educational institutions, up 13% from 2006.
