Aircraft take-offs and landings at the 93 Canadian airports with NAV CANADA air traffic control towers and flight service stations declined by 9.3% in September compared with September 2008. These 93 airports reported 537,093 movements in September compared with 592,094 movements at 95 airports in September 2008.
