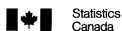

# Production and disposition of tobacco products

September 2009

Manufacturers produced 2.0 billion cigarettes in September, up 27.4% from August. The total number of cigarettes sold increased by 11.3% to 2.0 billion and closing inventories increased by 4.3% to 1.6 billion cigarettes in September.

**Note:** This survey collects data on the production of tobacco products in Canada by Canadian manufacturers and the disposition or sales of this production. It does not collect data on imported tobacco products. Therefore, sales information in this release is not a proxy for domestic consumption of tobacco products.

### Sawmills

August 2009

Monthly lumber production by sawmills decreased 1.1% to 3 597.3 thousand cubic metres in August. Compared with the same month last year, lumber production declined 17.8%

Sawmills shipped 3 636.9 thousand cubic metres of lumber in August, down 10.8% from July.
