## Crude oil and natural gas: Supply and disposition

August 2009 (preliminary)

Domestic production of crude oil and equivalent hydrocarbons totalled 13.1 million cubic metres in August, down 6.7% from August 2008.

Crude oil and equivalent exports were up 1.4% in August compared with the same month in 2008. About 73% of Canada's total domestic production went to the export market.

Marketable natural gas production declined 9.8% from the same month a year earlier to 11.4 billion cubic metres in August. Domestic sales of natural gas rose by 1.0% during the same period.

Natural gas exports rose by 5.9% compared with the same month a year earlier. Exports accounted

for about 77% of marketable natural gas production in August.

### **Aquaculture**

2008

Canadian aquaculture production decreased 5.5% in 2008 to 144 684 metric tonnes.

Structural changes in the industry, such as consolidations and closures, continued to affect the industry in 2008. Operating revenues declined 7.3% from \$810.1 million in 2007 to \$751.1 million in 2008.

The gross value added to the economy by the aquaculture industry fell to \$229.3 million, down 13.5% from 2007.
