# Production and disposition of tobacco products

November 2009

Canadian manufacturers produced 2.2 billion cigarettes in November, up 2.1% from the previous month. The total number of cigarettes sold decreased by 1.1% to 1.8 billion and closing inventories increased by 21.9% to 2.4 billion cigarettes in November.

**Note:** This survey collects data on the production of tobacco products in Canada by Canadian manufacturers and the disposition or sales of this production. It does not collect data on imported tobacco products. Therefore, sales information in this release is not a proxy for domestic consumption of tobacco products.

# **Couriers and Messengers Services Price Index**

November 2009

The Couriers and Messengers Services Price Index decreased 0.6% in November from October. The courier portion fell 0.9%, while the local messengers component rose 0.2%.

**Note:** The Couriers and Messengers Services Price Index is a monthly price index measuring the change over time in prices for courier and messenger services provided by long and short distance delivery companies to Canadian-based business clients.

Monthly lumber production by sawmills increased 3.9% to 4 344.1 thousand cubic metres in October. Compared with the same month last year, lumber production declined 17.1%.

Sawmills shipped 4 327.3 thousand cubic metres of lumber in October, up 4.9% from September.
