Crude oil and natural gas: Supply and disposition

July 2010 (preliminary)

Domestic production of crude oil and equivalent hydrocarbons totalled 14.4 million cubic metres in July, up 3.1% from June and 3.7% higher compared with July 2009.

Crude oil and equivalent exports were down 0.5% in July compared with the same month in 2009. About 70% of Canada's total domestic production went to the export market.

Marketable natural gas production totalled 11.5 billion cubic metres in July, down 4.8% from the same month a year earlier. This was in contrast to an increase in production of 6.9% from June to July 2010.

Domestic sales of natural gas increased by 6.0% in July compared with July 2009.

Natural gas exports rose by 2.2% in July from the same month a year earlier. Exports accounted for about 68% of marketable natural gas production.

Production and disposition of tobacco products

August 2010

Canadian manufacturers produced 2.0 billion cigarettes in August, up 10.3% from the previous month. The total number of cigarettes sold increased by 3.2% to 2.0 billion and closing inventories increased by 1.2% to 2.3 billion cigarettes in August.

Note: This survey collects data on the production of tobacco products in Canada by Canadian manufacturers and the disposition or sales of this production. It does not collect data on imported tobacco products. Therefore, sales information in this release is not a proxy for domestic consumption of tobacco products.


